



**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and A & D Gaming, LLC d/b/a A & D Gaming, LLC (hereinafter, the "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has sent a Notice of Recommendation of Revocation to the Licensee, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by said Notice are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office.

**WHEREAS**, the Division and the Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with said Notice;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS**

1. The Licensee is a Type 6 licensed establishment located at 221 Felix Road, Breaux Bridge, Louisiana, 70517.



2. The Division mailed a Video Gaming Advisory Notice to the Licensee informing them of the requirement to submit the annual fee and forms no later than July 1, 2018.

3. The Division did not receive the required annual forms and fee until January 25, 2019.

4. The Licensee failed to timely submit the required annual forms and fee, in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4), and La. R.S. 27:435(K)(4)(a) and (d).

5. The Division's records indicate that Chad Angelle and Terry Dauphine each held 50% of the membership interest in the Licensee.

6. On or about July 10, 2017, Chad Angelle and Terry Dauphine each sold their 50% membership interests in the Licensee to Daniel Gerard Green.

7. As a result of the transfer, Daniel Gerard Green now holds 100% of the membership interest in the Licensee.

8. The Licensee did not notify the Division of the change in membership until January 25, 2019, more than ten calendar days after the transfer of membership interest, in violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).

9. The Licensee failed to timely submit suitability documents for Daniel Gerard Green and his spouse, Tammy Green, in violation of La. R.S. 27:427(D).

10. The Licensee submitted suitability documents for Daniel Gerard Green and Tammy Green with the notification on January 25, 2019. No issues were found that would preclude them from participating in the video gaming industry.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. In lieu of administrative action, the Licensee will pay a penalty of **TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY and 00/100 (\$2,250.00) DOLLARS** for its violation of

La. R.S. 27:427(D), La. R.S. 27:435(K)(4)(a) and (d), LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4), and LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).

2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a total penalty of **TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY and 00/100 (\$2,250.00) DOLLARS** shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Revocation.

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. If approved, the Licensee agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. The Licensee agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the

gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
