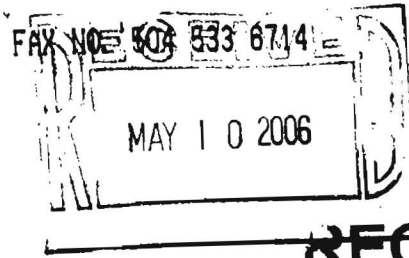



COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Jazz Casino Company, L.L.C. d/b/a Harrah's New Orleans (hereinafter "Harrah's New Orleans") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Harrah's New Orleans alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the Issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on May 10, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Harrah's New Orleans are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. On or about March 7, 2005, Division agents sent an advisory notice to Harrah's New Orleans informing that casino advertising billboards must post the "1-800 Problem Gambling" hotline number (the "Hotline Number").

2. On April 15, 2005, the Division began enforcing the Advisory Notice. On or about April 25, 2005, a Division agent traveled to the Harrah's New Orleans billboard located at U.S. Highway 61-West at Pasadena Drive in Metairie, Louisiana and determined that the Hotline Number was shown on the billboard. The Division agent determined that the Hotline Number was not posted in a manner such that a reasonable man could read it at normal highway speeds.

3. On March 6, 2006, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Harrah's New Orleans alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Harrah's New Orleans agrees to pay to the Division the aggregate and complete sum of FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS.

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Harrah's New Orleans's payment of the above stated amount in full and final settlement of this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.

3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Harrah's New Orleans, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether

to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement shall result in the immediate suspension of Harrah's New Orleans's license.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.


ORDER


