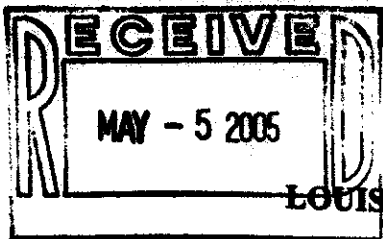

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:


1. the Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. Spencer Coburn, permit number P040023652 (hereinafter "permittee"), who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. The Division received notice from the Louisiana Department of Revenue, on or about January 14, 2004, that the permittee was delinquent in the filing of all applicable tax returns or in the payment of all taxes owed;
2. Based on this notice, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to the permittee on February 22, 2005;
3. A timely hearing request was submitted and this matter has been set for hearing on May 5, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Joseph E. Anzalone.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the permittee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The permittee acknowledges that he was in violation of La. R.S. 27:28 (A)(1, 2 & 4), La. R.S. 27:28 (B)(3) and 27:28 (F), in that he was not current in the filing of all applicable tax returns or in the payment of all taxes owed to the Louisiana Department of Revenue for a portion of the existence of his permit;
2. The permittee has provided to the Division a tax clearance certificate granted on March 23, 2005;
3. In lieu of suspension of the permittee's non-key gaming employee permit, the permittee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;

4. The Division hereby agrees to accept the permittee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of this Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty;
5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this violation in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Spencer Coburn pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Board within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the casino gaming permit of the permittee being suspended until the civil penalty is paid in full;
8. The Division and the permittee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.



4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the casino gaming permit of the permittee being suspended until the civil penalty is paid in full.


