

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

- 1. the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), represented by the undersigned Assistant Attorney General, and
- 2. 200 Magazine, Inc. d/b/a Huey's 24/7 (herein "applicant"),

who respectfully enter the following stipulations into the record:

WHEREAS:

- 1. Following an investigation of the Original Type 2 Video Gaming License Application of the applicant, the Division recommended denial of the application;
- 2. Based on the Division's recommendation, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Denial of Original Application to the applicant on July 1, 2004, citing violation of La. R.S 27:308(B), La. R.S. 310(B)(1)(a), (b) and (c) and La. R.S. 27:310(B)92); and
- 5. This matter is scheduled for hearing on December 14, 2004 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations and the particular facts and circumstances of this matter, the Division and the applicant hereby propose the following settlement:

Representative

- 1. The applicant acknowledges the facts as stated in the Notice of Recommendation of Denial of Original Application are accurate and correct and that Jason Doyle, its 100% shareholder, failed to conduct himself in a professional manner when communicating with the Division and failed to provide information requested by the division in a timely manner;
- 2. The applicant acknowledges that these actions constitute violations of L.A.C. 42:XI.2417(A)(2) and L.A.C. 42:XI.2505(A)(9);
- 3. The applicant shall pay a civil penalty in sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00);
- 4. Upon receipt of the civil penalty, the Division shall recommend that the applicant be approved for a Type 2 video gaming license.
- 5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
- 6. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
- 7. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and 200 Magazine, Inc. d/b/a Huey's 24/7 to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
- 8. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, the applicant must pay the above civil penalty to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval it is only when the civil penalty is paid in full that the Division will recommend that the applicant be approved for a Type 2 video gaming license; and
- 9. The Division and the applicant waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.
