COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and HAROLD L. ROSBOTTOM, JR. d/b/a GAMING SOLUTIONS (hereinafter "Gaming Solutions") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Gaming Solutions alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on October 11, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Gaming Solutions are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. An advertisement on behalf of video gaming distributor Harold Rosbottom, Jr. d/b/a Gaming Solutions appeared in the March 2006 edition of <u>SB Magazine</u>, a monthly magazine devoted to the politics, sports, business and cultural scene of Shreveport/Bossier City.

- 2. Gaming Solutions is the Louisiana distributor of Spielo video gaming devices. The advertisement in <u>SB Magazine</u> included a photograph of the Spielo video gaming device Power Station 5, with the caption, "BIG BOY IS HERE! YOU'LL PLAY IT ALL NIGHT LONG!" The advertisement, which included the phone number of Gaming Solutions, failed to include the required toll-free telephone number for problem gambling.
- 3. The licensee is mandated by La. R.S. 27:27.3 to place the toll-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling (or other similar, Board-approved toll-free telephone number) in any advertisement related to gaming. Gaming Solutions requested the number be placed on the billboard; however, Ryan and Company failed to follow these instructions and the number was omitted. The Division issued Violation/Inspection Report #12668 to the licensee, on or about March 17, 2006.

On July 18, 2006, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Gaming Solutions alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Gaming Solutions agrees to pay to the Division the aggregate and complete sum of TWO HUNDRED FIFTYAND NO/100 (\$250.00) DOLLARS.
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Gaming Solutions' payment of the above stated amount in full and final settlement of this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Gaming Solutions, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein

and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of

the parties.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the

Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether

to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

Failure to pay TWO HUNDRED FIFTYAND NO/100 (\$250.00) DOLLARS within fifteen (15)

days of approval of this settlement shall result in the immediate suspension of Gaming Solutions'

license without the necessity of further administrative action.

6. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these stipulations in

connection with any future violation(s), assessment of penalty or determination of the suitability

of Harold L. Rosbottom, Jr. and Gaming Solutions.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms

and conditions hereof.
