COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Onice October Police (hereinafter "the Division") and Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks, VGL 3601113704, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks, which notice alleges certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on February 22, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks, a licensed video gaming establishment, previously entered into a video poker device agreement with Master Video Poker.

- 2. Master Video Poker sent video gaming documents ("the Documents") to Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks for execution, including but not limited to the Video Gaming Application/Signature page, dated August 7, 2003, which was signed by Jason Blitch, the Video Gaming Application/Signature page, dated August 7, 2003, signed by Mary Holt and the Video Gaming Application/Signature page, dated August 7, 2003, signed by Joseph Holt.
- 3. Jason Blitch, Mary Holt and Joseph Holt are members of Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks.
- 4. Jason Blitch, Mary Holt and Joseph Holt admit that they did not sign the Documents in the presence of a notary and the Documents were not notarized in the Affiant's presence. Thus, the Documents were improperly notarized in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(A)(15).
- 5. On December 7, 2005, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks, VGL 3601113704 alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.
- 6. Jason Blitch, Mary Holt and Joseph Holt represent that all of the statements, responses, disclosures and representations provided in documents submitted to the Division bearing their signatures, are true and correct to the best of their knowledge, information and belief, and represent a complete and accurate account of the requested information.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Any and all information discovered throughout the course of this or any other investigation may be used in any future determination of the suitability of Jason Blitch, Mary Holt and Joseph Holt.
- 2. Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks agrees to pay a civil penalty of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

- 3. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
- 5. If approved, Friar Tucks II, Inc. d/b/a Friar Tucks must make payment of the civil penalty to the Division within ten (10) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.
- 6. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
