**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Boogie's Lounge, LLC d/b/a Boogie's Lounge (hereinafter, "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Violation to the Licensee, which contains allegations of a certain violation of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issue raised by the said Notice of Violation, is set for hearing June 16, 2014, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Violation;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS**

1. On March 20, 2014, the Division conducted an underage compliance inspection of the Licensee's establishment.

2. During the course of the Division's investigation of the Licensee, an employee of the Licensee allowed an underage patron to play a video gaming device and cashed out the underage patron's payout ticket.

3. The Licensee stipulates that it allowed an underage patron to play a video gaming device and subsequently cashed out the underage patron's payout ticket.

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee shall pay ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS for the violation of **La. R.S. 27:443**.

2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a civil penalty of ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Violation for the Licensee's violation of **La. R.S. 27:443**.

3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee must pay ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
