**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and B & B Brothers Cajun Critters, L.L.C. d/b/a Cajun Critters Seafood and More (hereinafter, "Cajun Critters") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Cajun Critters, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action has been set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Cajun Critters are desirous of fully and finally settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

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**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

### **STIPULATIONS**


1. Cajun Critters is a Type 2 licensed establishment located at 1029 West Tunnel Blvd., Houma, Louisiana 70360.
2. On February 2, 2015, the Division mailed a Video Gaming Advisory Notice to Cajun Critters informing them of the requirement to submit the annual fee and annual renewal application no later than July 1, 2015.
3. On June 30, 2015, Cajun Critters submitted an Annual Licensee Form and annual fee to the Division.
4. The documents were rejected by the Division and returned to Cajun Critters on or about July 10, 2015, with a listing of the missing required documentation.
5. On July 24, 2015, Cajun Critters re-submitted the Annual Licensee Form and annual fee to the Division.
6. The documents were again rejected by the Division and returned to Cajun Critters on or about July 28, 2015, with a listing of the missing required documentation.
7. On September 10, 2015, the Division received the required annual renewal forms and fee.
8. Cajun Critters failed to timely submit the required annual fee and supporting documents, a violation of **LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b)**.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**


1. In lieu of Administrative Action, Cajun Critters will pay a penalty of SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$750.00) DOLLARS for its violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).
2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Cajun Critters' payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action for Cajun Critters' violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).
3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Cajun Critters' suitability.
4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Cajun Critters, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if the Hearing Officer approves this proposed settlement, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
7. If approved, Cajun Critters agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming

Control Board. Cajun Critters agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.


