A true and correct copy of the proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference for all purposes.





**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Coca Cola Enterprises, Inc. (hereinafter, "Permittee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, on December 1, 2008, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to the Permittee, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty, are set for hearing on January 28, 2009, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

### STIPULATIONS

1. The Permittee stipulates that it failed to submit its Annual Affidavit Form and annual permit fee to the Division by its anniversary date of September 7, 2008, in violation of La. R.S 27:29(3)(F).

2. The Permittee also stipulates that it did not submit its Annual Affidavit form and annual permit fee to the Division until December 31, 2008.


### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Permittee shall pay Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$562.50) for the violations of La. R.S. 27:29(I) and La. R.S 27:29(3)(F).
2. The Division hereby agrees to accept a Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$562.50) penalty for the Permittee's violation of La. R.S. 27:29(I) and La. R.S 27:29(3)(F).
3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Permittee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessments of the Permittee's suitability.
6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will

be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.


7. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Permittee must pay Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$562.50) within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming permit without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.


