DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: JOHNETTE J. STAES NO. P040063243

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Johnette J. Staes, Permit No. P040063243, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated January 24, 2017, wherein her non-key gaming employee permit was revoked. The Hearing Officer found that Ms. Staes failed to meet her burden of proving her suitability.

We agree. Ms. Staes has a history of writing worthless checks. She gave conflicting reasons why she did not disclose these charges on her application. She made conflicting statements concerning who wrote the checks and who paid the checks.

Everyone who has or desires the privilege of possessing a gaming employee permit is required to demonstrate by clear and convincing evidence that they are suitable. La. R.S. 27:28(A). A suitable person is one of "good character, honesty, and integrity." La. R.S. 27:28(A)(1). A suitable person is one who is likely to conduct the business of gaming and financial arrangements incidental thereto in a suitable, fair and legal manner and will do so in accordance with laws and regulations. La. R.S. 27:28(A)(2) and (3).

Not only did Ms. Staes fail to prove her suitability but the evidence and testimony show that Ms. Staes is unsuitable to possess a gaming employee permit. It was appropriate to revoke her permit.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Hearing Officer's decision is AFFIRMED.
