COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Louisiana Casino Cruises, Inc. d/b/a Casino Rouge (hereinafter "Casino Rouge") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Casino Rouge alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on March 22, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Casino Rouge are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. On or about March 7, 2005, Division agents sent an advisory notice to Casino Rouge informing that casino advertising billboards must post the "1-800 Problem Gambling" hotline number (the "Hotline Number").

4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement

between the Division and Casino Rouge, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and

supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the

parties.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the

Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this

proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether

to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

Failure to pay SIX THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$6,000.00) DOLLARS within fifteen (15) days

of approval of this settlement shall result in the immediate suspension of Casino Rouge's license.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms

and conditions hereof.
