JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

- 1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (hereinafter "Division"), and
- 2. Gaubert Food Marts, Inc. d/b/a B & B Restaurants, License No. 2900210749 (hereinafter "licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

- on or about February 5, 2001, the Division conducted an on-site inspection of the licensee's establishment, and discovered the following violation:
 - a) the required compulsive gamblers toll-free telephone number was not posted in the gaming area or in any other location within the establishment;
- 2. pursuant to this information, and because there was no promulgated fine for this violation at the time, the Division issued a Notice of Violation and Hearing (Inspection Report #011128) to the licensee on or about March 26, 2001, alleging violation of La. R.S. 27:320;
- 3. this matter has been scheduled for hearing on May 8, 2001 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable J. E. Anzalone, Jr.;
- 4. since the violation, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has expressly set forth in LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(17) that the penalty for a first-offense failure to post the required toll-free number shall be \$250.00; and

5. the respective parties have exchanged information, and all parties desire to settle this matter.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

- 1. the licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:320 in that the correct toll-free compulsive gamblers telephone number was not posted in the gaming area, nor in the establishment;
- 2. the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty, which is consistent with the recently promulgated LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(17);
- 3. the Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 011128;
- 4. the Division reserves the right to take into consideration this violation in connection with any future violation;
- 5. the form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
- 6. this settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Gaubert Food Marts, Inc. d/b/a B & B Restaurants pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
- 7. this settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board;
- 8. the failure of the licensee to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the suspension of its license; and

9. the Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.
