

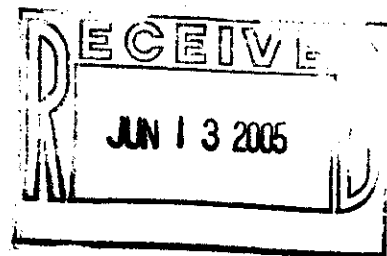

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT


ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. MARY S. KENT, Permit No. P040004866 (hereinafter "permittee"), who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:


1. On May 24, 2004, the Division received notification from the Louisiana Department of Revenue that permittee was not current in the filing of all applicable tax returns or in the payment of all taxes owed. Permittee was notified on June 9, 2004, by certified mail that permittee had thirty (30) days to provide the Division with documentation that a tax clearance had been issued. The permittee did not provide documentation of a tax clearance to the Division until on or about May 16, 2005.
2. The permittee is mandated by La. R.S. 27:28(B)(3) to remain current with all tax filings and payments owed to the State of Louisiana.
3. The permittee was issued a *Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty* by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on or about March 9, 2005.
4. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on June 9, 2005, at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Joseph E. Anzalone.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the permittee hereby propose the following settlement, that:



Considering the foregoing Joint Motion for Entry of Stipulations and Approval of Proposed Settlement, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such proposed settlement be approved, to wit:

1. The permittee acknowledges that she was notified on or about June 9, 2004, by certified mail that she had thirty (30) days to provide the Division with documentation that a tax clearance had been issued and that she did not provide documentation of a tax clearance to the Division until May 16, 2005.
2. the permittee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit of the permittee being suspended until such time as penalty is paid in full.
