COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Cajun Kitchen Seafood & Poboys, L.L.C. d/b/a Cajun Kitchen Seafood & Poboys (hereinafter, the "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the Licensee, which notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. The Licensee stipulates that it failed to timely file an Annual Report with Louisiana Secretary of State and was consequently deemed to be "not in good standing" with the Louisiana Secretary of State.
- 2. The Division stipulates that the Louisiana Secretary of State reports the Licensee "in good standing" as of January 31, 2012.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licensee agrees to pay, within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, a civil penalty of five hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$500.00) for violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(1)(a) and LAC 42:XI.2417(A)(1).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a civil penalty of five hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$500.00) shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted stipulations and violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future determination of the suitability of the Licensee.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the Licensee's failure to timely submit the annual form and fees as required by gaming law and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing

Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

6. If approved, the Licensee must make full payment of the civil penalty to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the License without the

necessity of any further administrative action.

7. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement, understand it, and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
