

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and La Cajun Gold Seafood d/b/a The Hideaway Lounge, VGL No. 5000112073, (hereinafter the "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the Licensee, which notice alleges certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on August 1, 2007, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notices of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. The Internal Revenue Service notified the Division that Mr. and Mrs. Horton (hereinafter the "Hortons"), as individuals and co-owners of La Cajun Gold Seafood d/b/a The Hideaway Lounge, and La Cajun Gold Seafood d/b/a The Hideaway Lounge, as a business, were ineligible for the required tax clearances.

2. On July 25, 2006, the Division issued a letter, via certified mail, instructing the Hortons and the Licensee to resolve the delinquencies within fifteen (15) days. The letter was received on July 26, 2006. Subsequent to receipt of the letter, La Cajun Gold Seafood d/b/a The Hideaway Lounge, as a business, received a tax clearance but the Hortons, as individuals, remained ineligible for a tax clearance.

3. On June 1, 2007, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

4. The Licensee acknowledges it was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405B(1)(b), in that the co-owners did not remain eligible for the required tax clearances for a portion of the existence of the license.


5. Both the business and the co-owners have now received tax clearance from the IRS.


TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Any and all information discovered throughout the course of this investigation may be used in connection with any future violation(s), assessment of penalty or in any future determination of the suitability of Sidney and Louise Horton and/or the Licensee.
2. The Licensee agrees to pay a civil penalty of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).
3. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
5. If approved, the Licensee must make payment of the civil penalty to the Division within ten (10) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

6. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement, understand it, and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.


