

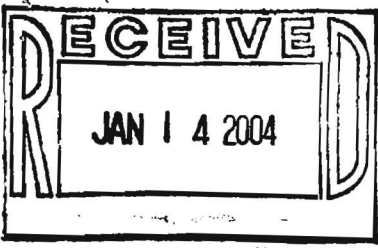

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Casino Gaming Section (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. Natalie Vincent, Permit No. P0400416668 (hereinafter "Permittee"), who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On or about May 27, 2003, Permittee submitted an application for a Non-Key Gaming Permit. A background investigation was performed and a permit was issued with an expiration date of May 30, 2005.
2. The Division received notification from the Louisiana Department of Revenue on or about June 5, 2003, that the Permittee was not current in the filing of all applicable tax returns or in the payment of all taxes owed pursuant to La. R.S. 27:28B(3).
3. The Division notified the Permittee, by certified mail, that if the tax problem was not resolved, the permit would be suspended. The certified mail receipt indicates the Permittee signed for and received the notification from the Section on or about June 18, 2003.
4. As of October 31, 2003, the Division had not received the required tax clearances.
5. On or about November 17, 2003, the Permittee received a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension.
6. On November 25, 2003, the Administrative Hearing Office received a Request for Hearing from the Permittee. Also attached was a letter from Nancy Jones of the Louisiana Department of Revenue stating that the taxpayer previously denied was now approved.

7. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on January 13, 2004 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Joseph E. Anzalone.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the Permittee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The Permittee acknowledges that she was in violation of La. R.S. 27:28(A)(4) and (B)(3), in that she was not current in the filing of or in the payment of all applicable taxes;
2. The Permittee is now current in the filing of or in the payment of all applicable taxes;
3. In lieu of suspension of the Non-Key Gaming Permit, Permittee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
4. The Division hereby agrees to accept the Permittee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of this Notice of Recommendation of Suspension;
5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this violation in connection with any future violation;
6. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
7. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Natalie Vincent, Permit # P040041668, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
8. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the Non-Key Gaming Permit of the Permittee being suspended or revoked and

9. The Division and the Permittee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.



3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the Non-Key Gaming Permit of Natalie Vincent, Permit No. P040041668 being suspended or revoked.
