COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State

LIC. NO.: 3601114959

Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and The Phoenix Bar Complex d/b/a Phoenix (hereinafter,

"Phoenix") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of

Recommendation of Administrative Action to Phoenix, which Notice contains allegations of

certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issue raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative

Action has been set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative

Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Phoenix are desirous of fully and finally settling all issues

and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of

Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby

agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. Phoenix is a Type 1 licensed establishment located at 941 Elysian Fields Avenue, New Orleans, Louisiana 70117.
- 2. On February 18, 2014, the Division mailed a Gaming Enforcement Advisory Notice to Phoenix informing them of the requirement and deadline to submit the annual fee and annual renewal application.
- 3. On June 16, 2014, the Division mailed an Urgent Reminder to Phoenix reminding them that they had not submitted their Annual License Fee and Licensee Forms and providing information about surrendering the gaming license.
- 4. On December 2, 2014, Phoenix submitted the required documents and annual fee to the Division.
- 5. Phoenix failed to timely submit the required annual fee and supporting documents, a violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. In lieu of Administrative Action of its Gaming License, Phoenix will pay a civil penalty of SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$750.00) DOLLARS for its violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Phoenix's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action for the licensee's violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(a) and (b).
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Phoenix's suitability.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted

under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement

between the Division and Phoenix, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and

supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and

understandings of the parties.

This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the 6.

Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that

if the Hearing Officer approves this proposed settlement, this agreement is not thereby

executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its

determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing

Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

If approved, Phoenix agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty to the 7.

Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming

Control Board. Phoenix agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in

immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further

administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all

stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
