



**TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING OFFICER:**





**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "the Division") and Constructive Solutions, Inc. (hereinafter "CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC.") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty are set for hearing on December 20, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office, and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

## **STIPULATIONS**

1. On April 28, 2006, the Louisiana Office of State Police issued, via U.S. mail, an Annual Affidavit form to CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. was to submit the Annual Affidavit and the annual permit fee by August 22, 2006, which represents the anniversary date of its Non-Gaming Supplier Permit.

2. On June 22, 2006, the Division mailed an URGENT REMINDER to CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. via U.S. mail. As of September 7, 2006 the permittee had not submitted an Annual Affidavit form or the annual permit fee.

3. On October 5, 2006, CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. submitted its Annual Affidavit and the annual permit fee to the Louisiana Office of State Police.

4. On October 10, 2006, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

5. CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. does admit it violated La. R.S.27:29(I) and La. R.S. 27:29.3(F).

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC. will pay a civil penalty of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) and SIXTY-TWO DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$62.50) pursuant to La. R.S. 27:29.5(C).

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC.'S payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty issued on October 10, 2006.

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty.


4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC., pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement shall result in the immediate suspension of CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS, INC.' S permit.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.


