**TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING OFFICER:**



A true and correct copy of the proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference for all purposes.





**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "the Division") and LA Spuds, Inc. d/b/a Spudly's Super Spuds (hereinafter "LA Spuds, Inc."), VGL 2600212010, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, on May 24, 2006, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to LA Spuds, Inc. d/b/a Spudly's Super Spuds alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on August 23, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and LA Spuds, Inc. are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

## STIPULATIONS

1. Laurie Aicklen is the President and 100% shareholder of LA Spuds, Inc. d/b/a Spudly's Super Spuds.
2. LA Spuds, Inc. d/b/a Spudly's Super Spuds, a licensed video gaming establishment, previously entered into a video poker device agreement with Master Video Poker.
3. The Division sent video gaming documents ("the Documents") to LA Spuds, Inc. d/b/a Spudly's Super Spuds for execution before a notary, including but not limited to the *Request to Release Information* dated July 21, 2000; the *Annual Licensee Form* dated March 12, 2002, and the *Annual Licensee Form* dated April 14, 2003, all signed by Laurie Aicklen.
4. Laurie Aicklen admits that she did not sign the Documents in the presence of a notary and the Documents were not notarized in the Affiant's presence. Further, investigation by the Division revealed that the purported Notary was not a notary. Thus, the Documents were improperly notarized in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(A)(15).
5. Laurie Aicklen represents that all of the statements, responses, disclosures and representations provided in the documents submitted to the Division bearing her signature are true and correct to the best of her knowledge, information and belief, and represents a complete and accurate account of the requested information.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, LA Spuds, Inc. shall pay a civil penalty of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00).
2. The Division hereby agrees to accept the payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of all violations alleged in the May 24, 2006, Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
3. Any and all information discovered throughout the course of this or any other investigation may be used in any future determination of the suitability of Laurie Aicklen, and LA Spuds, Inc.
4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and LA Spuds, Inc. pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. If approved, however, payment of the above penalty must be submitted to the Division within (15) fifteen days of approval of this settlement by the Board. The failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the immediate suspension of the license until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
