DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

H & D ARMOUR, INC. D/B/A MULE'S RESTAURANT & BAR NO. 3601615268

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by H & D Armour, Inc. d/b/a Mule's Restaurant & Bar ("Mule's"), License No. 3601615268, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated February 12, 2016, wherein a \$750 civil penalty was imposed for failure to timely submit the Annual Licensee Form and fee, tax clearance certificates, a copy of alcohol license, and the Record Update Form.

Mule's is asking that the civil penalty be waived and that it be allowed to surrender its license. The basis for this request is the illness and subsequent death of the owner/manager of the licensee. The basis for this request is not part of the record and therefore cannot be considered.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence supporting Mule's request. He will consider any new evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.
