**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Joel C. Jones (hereinafter, "Permittee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, on March 26, 2009, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action, are set for hearing on June 17, 2009, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS**

1. The Permittee stipulates that he was arrested by Bossier City Police on February 6, 2009.

2. The Permittee stipulates that he failed to timely notify the Division of his arrest, in violation of LAC 42:XIII.2901(B)(4).


#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Permittee shall pay Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for the violation of LAC 42:XIII.2901(B)(4).
2. The Division hereby agrees to accept a Two Hundred and Fifty Dollar (\$250.00) penalty for the Permittee's violation of LAC 42:XIII.2901(B)(4).
3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.
6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
7. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee must pay Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure

to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming permit without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.




