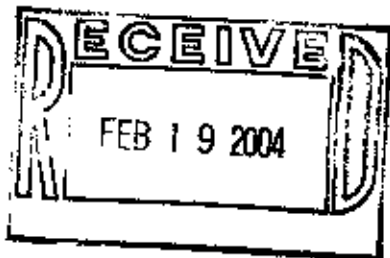

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**


ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (hereinafter, "Division"), and
2. Dorothy Boyd d/b/a Fred's Amusement, license number 0300600107 (hereinafter, "licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On June 10, 2003, the Louisiana State Police, General Gaming Division, Gaming Suitability Unit conducted an on-site inspection of Modern Gaming, Inc., a casino gaming supplier permittee;
2. During that inspection, it was discovered that:
 - a. on or about March 27, 2003, the licensee, a Type 6 video gaming licensee, purchased two video monitors from Modern Gaming for the sum of \$1,653.00; and
 - b. although Modern Gaming possessed a valid casino gaming permit at the time of these transactions, it was not licensed by the Division as a distributor of video draw poker devices and equipment;
3. Pursuant to this information, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the licensee on January 13, 2004; and
4. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on March 23, 2004, at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Unit and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:


1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2411(D)(4), in that it purchased video gaming device equipment from an entity not licensed by the Division as a Type 8 video gaming distributor;
2. In lieu of further administrative action, the licensee shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)**;
3. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Dorothy Boyd d/b/a Fred's Amusement pertaining to the subject matter contained therein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the Type 6 license of the licensee being suspended; and
8. The Unit and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.



1. the licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XL2411(D)(4), in that it purchased video gaming device equipment from an entity not licensed by the Division as a Type 8 video gaming distributor;
2. in lieu of further administrative action, the licensee shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)**;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the Type 6 license of the licensee being suspended.
