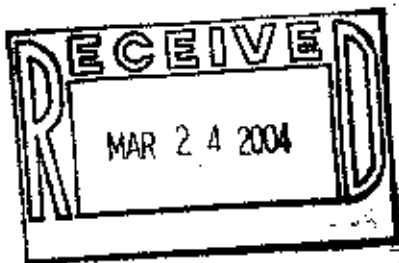

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Gaming Suitability Unit (hereinafter "Unit"), and
2. ALLTEL Communications Wireless, Inc., formerly known as CenturyTel Wireless, Inc., (hereinafter "permittee" or "ALLTEL")

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. The Unit contends that on or about May 07, 2003, the Unit mailed the 2003 Annual Affidavit Form to permittee instructing it to submit the Annual Affidavit Form and annual permit fee by August 16, 2003, the anniversary date of the non-gaming supplier permit held by CenturyTel and that the permittee is mandated by LSA R.S. 27:29.3.F to submit its annual fee on the anniversary date of the issuance of the permit each year.
2. ALLTEL contends that neither CenturyTel nor ALLTEL provided services under the permit to any casino in the previous two years and to any horse track in the previous year.
3. On or about December 23, 2003, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension to the permittee.
4. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on March 23, 2004 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. ALLTEL herewith voluntarily surrenders without prejudice the original permit granted to CenturyTel;
2. ALLTEL herewith submits an Affidavit of Loss with respect to the renewal permit granted to CenturyTel;
3. ALLTEL agrees to a civil penalty in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) as full and final settlement of this matter;
4. ALLTEL waives its right (in reliance on the terms of this settlement agreement) to the hearing currently scheduled for March 23, 2004;
5. ALLTEL understands that, once an order is issued setting forth the terms of this settlement agreement and once ALLTEL thereafter remits payment in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00), this matter will be resolved in its entirety and the file will be closed;
6. ALLTEL agrees that the form and substance of this settlement agreement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
7. ALLTEL agrees that this settlement agreement shall constitute the entire agreement between the licensee, and the Division pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties; and
8. ALLTEL agrees that this settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalty must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the permit being suspended.

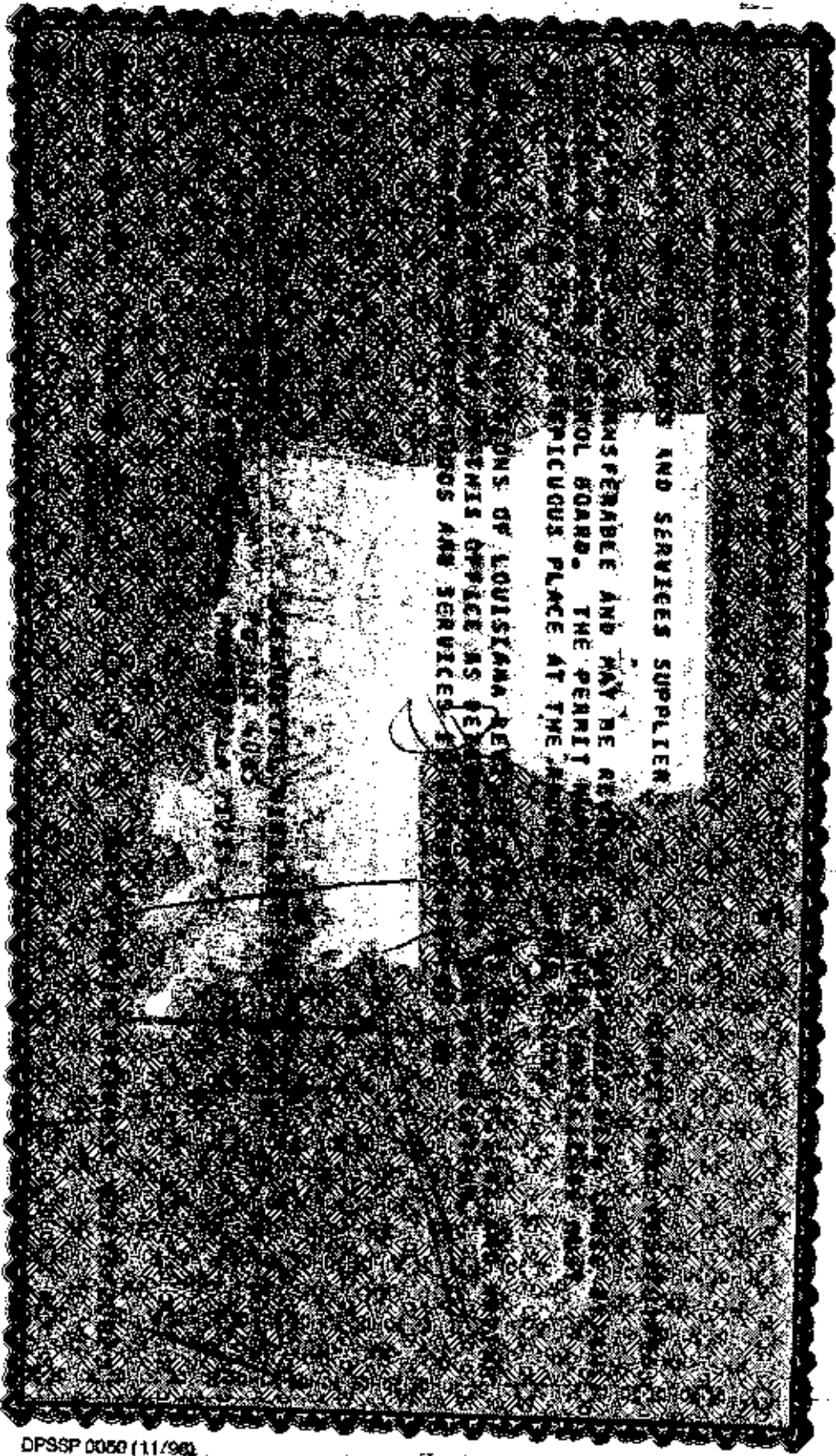
1. ALLTEL shall voluntarily surrender without prejudice the original permit granted to CenturyTel;

3. ALLTEL shall pay on behalf of CenturyTel a \$500.00 civil penalty;
4. Payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board;
5. The failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in CenturyTel's non-gaming supplier permit being suspended; and
6. The hearing scheduled for March 23, 2004 shall be canceled, and any appropriate hearing costs shall be refunded to ALLTEL.
7. This matter shall be closed.
