**DECISION OF THE
LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD**

**MALLET ENTERPRISES, INC. D/B/A
ENCORE NITE CLUB
NO. 3601116921**

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Mallet Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Encore Nite Club ("Encore"), License No. 3601116921, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated February 16, 2016, wherein Encore's video gaming license was revoked for failure to submit the Annual Licensee Form and fee, tax clearance certificates, a copy of its alcohol license, and the Record Update Form.

In its appeal, Encore alleges that it has submitted all documents and the annual fee and requests that this matter be remanded to the Hearing Officer for consideration of the new evidence. The Louisiana State Police asks that the Hearing Officer's decision be affirmed or, in the alternative, that the matter be remanded for consideration of the new evidence.

The new evidence is not part of the record and therefore cannot be considered.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence regarding the submission of all required documents and the annual fee. He will consider any new evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.
