JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS
AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Casino Gaming Division (hereinafter "Division"), through the undersigned Assistant Attorney General, and
2. Nolmar Corporation, permit number CGD020088 (sometimes herein "Nolmar"),

who respectfully enter the following stipulations into the record:

WHEREAS:

1. On or about July 1, 2002, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Violation and Hearing to Nolmar Corporation based on the provisions found in La. R.S. 27:68(A), LAC 42:XIII.2501, LAC 42:XIII.2505, LAC 42:XIII.2507 and LAC 42:XIII.2509;
2. The above-referenced notice alleges that on or about April 1, 2001, Nolan Marshall transferred one hundred-twenty-five (125) shares in Nolmar Corporation as follows:
 - a) 48.7 shares to June E. Marshall;
 - b) 45.1 shares to Allison Marshall;
 - c) 30.6 shares to Robyn Marshall-Wallace; and
 - d) 0.6 shares to Robert J. Donnes;
3. The notice further alleges that Nolmar failed to seek prior approval for the transfers from the Division, nor did it notify the Division of the transfers until September of 2001, when Nolmar filed suitability documents with the Division for June E. Marshall;

4. Prior to the April 2001 transfers, Allison Marshall, Robyn Marshall-Wallace and Robert J. Donnes had previously meet suitability in conjunction with this permit. June E. Marshall has since been found suitable by the Division;
5. This matter has been placed on Hearing Officer William H. Brown's docket for hearing on October 2, 2002 at 9:00 a.m..


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations, the Division and Nolmar Corporation hereby propose the following settlement:

1. Nolmar Corporation admits and acknowledges that it violated La. R.S. 27:68(A), LAC 42:XIII.2501, LAC 42:XIII.2505, LAC 42:XIII.2507 and LAC 42:XIII.2509, in that it did not seek prior approval for the transfers of interest made on or about April 1, 2001. nor did it notify the Division of such transfers until September of 2001;
2. In lieu of revocation or suspension of Nolmar Corporation's gaming permit, Nolmar will pay to the Division, as a civil penalty for non-compliance in the aggregate and complete sum of **FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4000.00)**;
3. Subject to the approval of the Hearing Office of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Division hereby agrees to accept Nolmar's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of this administrative action;
4. It is expressly understood that this proposed settlement, if approved by the Hearing Officer, is not executory and will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer. The parties hereby consent to this procedure;
5. The Division and Nolmar waive their rights to appeal this Stipulation if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and is accepted by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board;
6. The Division reserves the right to take this matter into consideration in connection with any subsequent violations;
7. This settlement is to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana; and
8. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Nolmar Corporation pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.


