

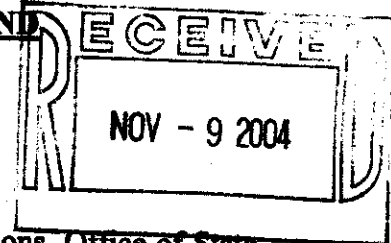

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND  
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT



ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. Logansport Gaming, LLC d/b/a Logansport Truck Stop, License No. 1601502532 (hereinafter "licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On October 31, 2003, an agent of the Division noted that a billboard sign located on LA Highway 5, which advertised the licensee's establishment, did not include the problem gambling toll-free telephone number;
2. The licensee is mandated by La. R.S. 27:27.3 to place the toll-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling (or other similar, Board-approved toll-free telephone number) in any advertisement of its gaming activities or licensed establishment;
3. Furthermore, at an October 31, 2003 on-site compliance inspection of the licensee's premises, an agent of the Division noted that the licensee was not in possession of a current video gaming administrative rule book;
4. The licensee was mandated by LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(16) to maintain a current copy of the video gaming administrative rule book at its licensed premises;
5. Pursuant to its agent's observations, the Division issued Violation/Inspection Report #012639 to the licensee on October 31, 2003, citing violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3 and LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(16). Attendant to this Violation/Inspection

Report, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the licensee on September 21, 2004;

6. This is the licensee's first violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3; and
7. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on November 30, 2004 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown,

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that it did not place the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number on the aforementioned billboard that advertises its gaming establishment;
2. Furthermore, the licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI2407(A)(16) in that it did not possess, at the time of the Division's October 31, 2004 on-site inspection, a current copy of the video gaming administrative rules at its premises;
3. In lieu of further administrative action against the licensee's video gaming license, the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty for the violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3 and a \$100.00 penalty for the violation of LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(16), which equals a total civil penalty in the amount of \$350.00;
4. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 012639 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
6. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
7. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Logansport Gaming, LLC d/b/a Logansport Truck Stop pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
8. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing

Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled; and


9. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.

**ORDER**

Considering the foregoing Joint Motion For Entry of Stipulations and Approval of Proposed Settlement, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such proposed settlement be approved, to wit:

1. the licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that it did not place the required problem gambling toll-free telephone number on the billboard that advertised its gaming establishment; furthermore, the licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI2407(A)(16) in that it did not possess, at the time of the Division's October 31, 2004 on-site inspection, a current copy of the video gaming administrative rules at its premises;
2. the licensee shall pay a \$350.00 civil penalty;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled.
