AMENDED COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and LTSGO, LLC d/b/a LTSGO, LLC (hereinafter, "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has sent a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Licensee, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by said Notice are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office.

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with said Notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. Licensee is a Type 6 licensed establishment located at 2401 Elysian Fields, New Orleans, Louisiana 70117.

- 2. On June 25, 2019, the Division received notice of the death of Bobbie Jean Maloney (hereinafter, "Ms. Maloney").
- 3. The Division's records indicated that Ms. Maloney held a 14.29% membership interest in Licensee.
- According to Ms. Maloney's death certificate, she passed away on January 29,
 Ms. Maloney died intestate, unmarried, and with no descendants.
- 5. At the time of her death, Ms. Maloney was survived by her parents, Robert S. Maloney and Bonny B. Maloney. Ms. Maloney was also survived by her siblings Kurt B. Maloney, Robert S. Maloney Jr., Julie A. Maloney-Wenck, and Craig S. Maloney (hereinafter, "Ms. Maloney's siblings").
 - 6. Ms. Maloney's father, Robert S. Maloney, died on June 2, 2019.
- 7. Ms. Maloney's 14.29% membership interest in Licensee transferred to Ms. Maloney's siblings in equal shares, subject to a usufruct of her living parent, Bonny B. Maloney.
- 8. There is no judgment of possession available at this time, however, naked ownership transferred to Ms. Maloney's siblings upon her death.
- 9. Ms. Maloney's siblings and Bonny B. Maloney have previously met suitability in connection with this license.
- The Division found no information to preclude their continued participation in the garning industry.
 - 11. Licensee is now compliant with Louisiana Gaming Law.
- 12. Licensee failed to notify the Division within ten calendar days of Ms. Maloney's death, in violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- In lieu of administrative action, Licensee will pay a penalty of FIVE HUNDRED and NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS for its violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).
- The Division hereby agrees that payment of a total penalty of FIVE HUNDRED and NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Licensee's suitability.
- 4. The terms of this Amended Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Amended Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Amended Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
- If approved, Licensee agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty within fifteen
 days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Licensee agrees

that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Amended Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
