

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and LOUISIANA COMMERCIAL LAUNDRY (hereinafter "La. Commercial Laundry") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to La. Commercial Laundry alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty are set for hearing on May 3, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and La. Commercial Laundry are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. On October 6, 2005, the Division issued, via U.S. mail, an Annual Affidavit form to La. Commercial Laundry. La. Commercial Laundry was to submit the Annual Affidavit and

the annual permit fee by January 16, 2006, which represents the anniversary date of its Non-Gaming Supplier Permit.

2. On December 8, 2005, the Division mailed an URGENT REMINDER to La. Commercial Laundry via U.S. mail. As of February 1, 2006, La. Commercial Laundry had not submitted an Annual Affidavit form or the annual permit fee.

3. On March 7, 2006, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to La. Commercial Laundry alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

4. La. Commercial Laundry's Annual Affidavit form and annual permit fee were received by the Division on or about March 20, 2006.

5. La. Commercial Laundry does admit it violated La. R.S.27:29(I) and La. R.S. 27:29.3(F).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. La. Commercial Laundry will pay a civil penalty of Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars and a penalty of Sixty Two Dollars and 50/100 ^{6/100} (\$562.50) Dollars pursuant to La. R.S. 27:29.5(C).

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept La. Commercial Laundry's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty issued on March 7, 2006.

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty.


4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and La. Commercial Laundry pertaining to the subject matter contained

herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement shall result in the immediate suspension of La. Commercial Laundry's permit.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
