DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: MONA L. HUNTER P040031174A

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Mona L. Hunter, P040031174, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated August 7, 2024, wherein her Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit was revoked. The basis of the disqualification was a pending criminal charge against the Permittee, which makes the Permittee ineligible to hold a gaming permit.

The Permittee now alleges that the criminal charge is no longer pending against her. Any new evidence is not part of the record and cannot be considered.

The Board remands this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of evidence regarding this allegation. The Hearing Officer will consider all evidence and render a decision accordingly. Either party may then appeal.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED THAT this matter be REMANDED for the purpose and reasons set forth in this decision.
