TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING OFFICER:


NOW COMES the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Original Pierre Maspero's, LLC d/b/a The Original Pierre Maspero's, License No. 3601212445 (hereinafter "Licensee"), who file this Joint Motion for Approval of Compromise and Settlement Agreement, and in support thereof would respectively show unto the Hearing Officer as follows:

1.

The Division and Licensee are desirous of compromising and settling all disputes between them relative to the referenced administrative proceeding. In connection therewith, the parties have entered into a compromise and settlement agreement which by its terms will become effective upon approval by the Administrative Hearing Office and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

STIPULATIONS

1. The Licensee stipulates that it failed to submit the Annual Licensee Form, fee, and the required tax clearance certificates by August 31, 2006, in violation of **La. R.S 27:311(K)(4) and L.A.C. 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(b)**.

2. The Licensee also stipulates that it did not send the Annual Licensee Form, fee, and required tax clearance documents until January 16, 2007.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee shall pay One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars for the violation of **La. R.S 27:311(K)(4) and L.A.C 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(b)**.

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept a One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollar penalty for the Licensee's violation of **La. R.S 27:311(K)(4) and L.A.C 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(b)**.


3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.


5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

6. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee must pay One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.


