

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

- 1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Garning Division (hereinafter "Division"), and
- 2. Elbert T. Gardner d/b/a Tony's Hilltop, License No. 0900112608 (hereinafter "Licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

- 1. On or about July 29, 2003, the Division conducted an inspection of the licensed establishment;
- 2. The investigating officer observed a portable outdoor advertisement sign at the intersection of Louisiana Highway 1 and Myrtis Texas Line Road that displayed on the north side, "Tony's Hilltop—Video Poker—Pool—Beer." The advertisement sign did not contain the number of the National Council on Problem Gaming or a similar toll-free number approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board;
- 3. Further inspection of the establishment revealed a video gaming Uniform Logo sign attached to the south outside wall of the establishment that did not contain the appropriate toll-free number;
- 4. On or about July 29, 2003, the Division issued Violation/Inspection Report #012655 citing violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3 to the Licensee;
- 5. Attendant to the Violation/Inspection Report, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the Licensee on or about October 30, 2003 for the Licensee/s failure to place the toll-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling or similar

toll-free number approved by the board on its signage advertising video gaming at the establishment;

6. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on December 29, 2003 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Joseph B. Anzalone, Jr.,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the Licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

- The Licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27:3, in that it did not include the toll-free number of the National Council on Problem Gambling or similar toll-free number approved by the board on its signage advertising video gaming;
- The Licensee has submitted evidence that the required telephone number has been installed to the appropriate signage on the south wall of the establishment, and the signage advertising video gaming on the portable sign has been removed, a copy of which is attached hereto;
- The Licensee understands that the corrective measures taken are only sufficient and accepted as long as the signage stays in its present location;
- In lieu of an administrative action, the Licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
- 4. The Division hereby agrees to accept the Licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 012655 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action:
- 5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
- The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
- This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
- 8. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the

failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being revoked and its gaming devices being disabled; and

The Division and the Licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.

Considering the foregoing Joint Motion For Entry of Stipulations and Approval of Proposed Settlement, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such proposed settlement be approved, to wit:

- the Licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:27.3, in that it
 did not include the toll-free number of the National Council on Problem
 Gambling or similar toll-free number approved by the board on its signage
 advertising video gaming;
- having signage advertising gaming activities at the gaming establishment without
 the toil-free telephone number of the National Council on Problem Gambling or
 similar telephone number affixed, the Licensee shall pay a civil penalty in the
 amount of \$250.00;
- payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15)
 days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
- 4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of Elbert T. Gardner d/b/a Tony's Hilltop being revoked and its gaming devices being disabled.




