Louisiana Gaming Control Board Meeting
January 19, 2023

1 I. CALL TO ORDER

2 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Good morning,
3 ladies and gentlemen. We're going to get
4 started right on time.

5 Good morning. I'd like to call to
6 order the Louisiana Gaming Control Board
7 meeting of Thursday, January the 19th of 2023.

8 And, Ms. Hood, would you call the
9 roll, please.

10 MS. HOOD: Chairman Johns?

11 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Here.

12 MS. HOOD: Mr. Avant?

13 (No response.)

14 MS. HOOD: Ms. Berry?

15 MS. BERRY: Here.

16 MS. HOOD: Mr. Jackson?

17 MR. JACKSON: Here.

18 MS. HOOD: Ms. Lewis?

19 MS. LEWIS: Here.

20 MS. HOOD: Mr. Poole?

21 MR. POOLE: Here.

22 MS. HOOD: Ms. Hamilton-Acker?

23 MS. HAMILTON-ACKER: Here.

24 MS. HOOD: Judge Sholes?

25 JUDGE SHOLES: Here.

1 MS. HOOD: Ms. Traylor?

2 MS. TRAYLOR: Here.

3 MS. HOOD: Colonel Davis?

4 MAJOR McNEAL: Major McNeal for
5 Colonel Davis.

6 MS. HOOD: And Secretary Richard?

7 SECRETARY RICHARD: Here.

8 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. We do have a
9 quorum. And thank you, Members, for coming
10 in. I know the agenda is short today. But
11 we -- we do have -- we do have some important
12 stuff.

13 II. PUBLIC COMMENTS

14 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: So at this time,
15 ladies and gentlemen, is the time for public
16 comment. If there is any public comments on
17 any matter that come before this board today,
18 now is the time to come forward.

19 Okay. I see no public comment.

20 III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

21 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Members, in your
22 packet, you have the minutes of the December
23 the 5th -- of the December the 9th and the
24 December the 15th, 2022, board meeting. I
25 would ask for a motion to waive the reading

1 and to approve the minutes.

2 MR. JACKSON: So moved.

3 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Mr. Jackson has
4 moved that we waive and approve the minutes of
5 December the 9th and December the 15th of
6 2022. And Ms. Berry has seconded that motion.

7 Is there any opposition to that
8 motion?

9 Hearing none, that motion carries.

10 IV. REVENUE REPORTS

11 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. We're going
12 to move into revenue reports. Ms. Jackson,
13 good morning.

14 MS. JACKSON: Good morning, Chairman
15 Johns -- am I on?

16 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: I think you're on.

17 MR. JACKSON: -- Board Members. My
18 name is Donna Jackson. I'm with Louisiana
19 State Police, Gaming Audit Section.

20 In December, the 14 operating
21 riverboats generated Adjusted Gross Receipts
22 of \$162,696,770. Horseshoe Lake Charles held
23 its grand opening on December 12th and
24 generated \$10,579,048 in AGR in 21 days of
25 operation. The state collected total fees of

1 \$34,979,806 during December.

2 Fiscal year to date Adjusted Gross
3 Receipts are \$856.7 million, a decrease of 2%
4 from last fiscal year.

5 As of December 31st, 2022, the state
6 collected \$184 million in fees for fiscal year
7 2023.

8 Page two shows the riverboat revenue
9 broken down by regional market. This month's
10 revenues represent an increase from November
11 of approximately \$27 million or 20%, but a
12 decrease of \$1.4 million or 1% compared to the
13 same month last year. This December had one
14 additional Saturday in the month than last
15 December.

16 Next is a summary of the
17 December 2022 gaming activity for Harrah's
18 New Orleans, found on page three. Harrah's
19 generated \$22,942,785 in gross gaming revenue.
20 These revenues represent a slight decrease
21 from last month of 1.6%, but an increase of
22 3.8% from last December. During December, the
23 state received \$5.5 million in minimum daily
24 payments.

25 Fiscal year to date Adjusted Gross

1 Receipts are \$133.5 million, an increase of
2 35% from last fiscal year. As of
3 December 31st, 2022, the state collected
4 \$32.8 million in fees for fiscal year 2023.

5 Next I will present the revenues for
6 Slots at the Racetracks. During December, the
7 four racetrack facilities combined generated
8 Adjusted Gross Receipts of \$26,071,636, an
9 increase of \$2.6 million or 11% from November
10 2022, but a decrease of \$2.6 million or 9%
11 when compared to the same month last year.
12 During December, the state collected
13 \$3.9 million in fees.

14 Fiscal year to date Adjusted Gross
15 Receipts are \$155.5 million, a decrease of
16 approximately \$6 million or 3.7% from fiscal
17 year 2022. As of December 31st, 2022, the
18 state has collected \$23.6 million in fees for
19 fiscal year 2023.

20 I will now move to the Video Gaming
21 information.

22 There are 12,197 video gaming
23 devices activated at 1,413 locations. Net
24 Device Revenue for December 2022 was
25 \$66,525,429, an increase of \$4.9 million or

1 7.9% when compared to November, but a decrease
2 of \$7.6 million or 10.3% when compared to last
3 December. Total Franchise Fees for
4 December 2022 totaled \$20.2 million.

5 Fiscal year to date Net Device
6 Revenue is \$384.5 million, a decrease of
7 \$19.4 million or 4.8% when compared to last
8 fiscal year.

9 As of December 31st, 2022, the state
10 has collected \$116.5 million in franchise fees
11 for fiscal year 2023.

12 Next I will present the December
13 revenue for sportsbook. During December, the
14 18 retail sportsbooks, with the addition of
15 Horseshoe Lake Charles, accepted \$35.6 million
16 in sports wagers, resulting in net proceeds of
17 \$6.4 million and \$609,000 in state fees. The
18 eight mobile sportsbook operators accepted
19 \$218.7 million in sports wagers, resulting in
20 net proceeds of \$30.5 million and \$3.7 million
21 in taxes paid to the state.

22 Finally, for Daily Fantasy Sports,
23 gross revenues for December were \$9.5 million,
24 with net revenue of approximately \$957,000 and
25 taxes of \$76,575.

1 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. Thank you
2 very much, Ms. Jackson.

3 Are there any questions from the
4 board members for Ms. Jackson? Any questions?

5 Members, I think you need to take
6 note of the Horseshoe numbers, where they did
7 around 10 million in those 21 days. They did
8 not affect the other two properties in Lake
9 Charles at all. They actually grew the market
10 in Lake Charles by around \$10 million. And
11 I'm comparing that to December of last year,
12 and also to November of 2022. So L'Auberge
13 Lake Charles and Golden Nugget's numbers were
14 fairly consistent. And Horseshoe grew the
15 market. So it's kind of interesting to watch
16 that. We're always concerned about
17 cannibalization of a market. So we -- I guess
18 only time will tell whether that holds up.

19 So, okay, any other questions for
20 Ms. Jackson? Okay. Hearing none,
21 Ms. Jackson, thank you so much for your great
22 work.

23 MS. JACKSON: Thank you.

24 V. CASINO GAMING ISSUES

25

1 A. Consideration of Certificate of Compliance
2 for St. Charles Gaming Company, LLC d/b/a
3 Horseshoe Casino Lake Charles - No R011700174

4 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. All right.
5 Moving along, Members, we move into Casino
6 Gaming Issues. Today we have the
7 Consideration of a Certificate of Compliance
8 for St. Charles Gaming Company, LLC, doing
9 business as, Horseshoe Casino Lake Charles.

10 Mr. Gathe, good morning.

11 MR. GATHE: Good morning, Chairman
12 Johns, Board Members. I'm Assistant Attorney
13 General Jeremy Gathe here in the matter of the
14 issuance of the Temporary Certificate of
15 Compliance for St. Charles Gaming Company,
16 LLC, doing business as, Horseshoe Casino Lake
17 Charles.

18 On December 9th, 2023, in connection
19 with the Horseshoe Lake Charles approval to
20 commence gaming operation, the Board approved
21 the Licensee's request for the issuance of a
22 Temporary Certificate of Compliance with an
23 expiration date of January 31st, 2023.

24 The Board granted a temporary COC
25 due to the Licensee receiving only a temporary

1 certificate of occupancy. The Louisiana
2 Office of State Fire Marshal ordered the
3 Licensee to continue implementation of a fire
4 watch at the 1st Floor North Podium Area of
5 the casino and granted the Licensee temporary
6 occupancy pending correction of cited
7 deficiencies. The State Fire Marshal advised
8 the Board that a reinspection for full
9 occupancy was scheduled for January 13th,
10 2023.

11 On January 6, 2023, the Licensee
12 requested a 60-day extension with the fire
13 marshal, because several deficiencies would
14 not be remedied by January 13th. The fire
15 marshal granted the inspection extension and
16 the Licensee's Temporary Certificate of
17 Occupancy through March 27th, 2023.

18 If it is the Board's pleasure to
19 extend the Temporary Certificate of Compliance
20 for the Horseshoe Casino Lake Charles, a
21 resolution has been prepared to grant a
22 Temporary Certificate of Compliance until
23 April 17th, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. to remedy any
24 discrepancies. That date is suggested as it
25 gets the Temporary COC through the next board

1 meeting, as the fire marshal is not scheduled
2 to go out until after the March board meeting.
3 This matter will be back before you for the
4 April agenda, unless the issue is remedied
5 prior to that for the March agenda.

6 And we do have Jeffrey Barbin who is
7 counsel for the Licensee that's available to
8 answer any questions that the Board Members
9 may have.

10 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. Thank you,
11 Mr. Gathe.

12 Are there any questions from the
13 Board?

14 So, Members, I personally have been
15 out to the Horseshoe a number of times since
16 their opening. I've had a lot of phone
17 conversations with their general manager.
18 They are -- they are moving along very well
19 with the, quote, deficiencies. And, as I
20 understand, none of these deficiencies are
21 life threatening in any way. And in the areas
22 of the casino, primarily, is where the public
23 actually does not go on a regular basis. So
24 we feel very comfortable. I have asked
25 Horseshoe to attend our February board meeting

1 and make a complete presentation to the Board
2 of where they are -- not only where they are
3 with these items, but also to give the Board a
4 very clear view of what they've accomplished
5 there in Lake Charles, what they've built. So
6 I think you'll see a very nice presentation at
7 the February board meeting.

8 So are there any questions?

9 Okay. I have no questions, so I
10 would ask for a motion to issue a Temporary
11 Certificate of Compliance, which will expire
12 on April the 17th of 2023.

13 Do I have a motion?

14 Ms. Hamilton-Acker has moved, and
15 Mr. Poole has seconded that motion.

16 And, Ms. Hood, would you read the
17 resolution, please.

18 MS. HOOD: On the 19th day of
19 January, 2023, the Louisiana Gaming Control
20 Board did, in a dually-noticed-public meeting,
21 consider the issue of St. Charles Gaming
22 Company, LLC, doing business as, Horseshoe
23 Casino Lake Charles' Temporary Riverboat
24 Gaming Landside Facility Certificate of
25 Compliance, and upon motion dually made and

1 seconded, the Board adopted this resolution.

2 Be it resolved that the licensee's
3 request for a Temporary Riverboat Gaming
4 Landside Facility Certificate of Compliance is
5 hereby approved with an expiration date of
6 April 17th, 2023, at 11:59 p.m., thus done and
7 signed in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, this 19th
8 day of January, 2023.

9 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Thank you,
10 Ms. Hood.

11 So Members, we have a resolution
12 that's been offered by Ms. Hamilton-Acker,
13 seconded by Mr. Poole.

14 And, Ms. Hood, would you call the
15 roll, please.

16 MS. HOOD: Ms. Berry?

17 MS. BERRY: Yes.

18 MS. HOOD: Mr. Jackson?

19 MR. JACKSON: Yes.

20 MS. HOOD: Ms. Lewis?

21 MS. LEWIS: Yes.

22 MS. HOOD: Mr. Poole?

23 MR. POOLE: Yes.

24 MS. HOOD: Ms. Hamilton-Acker?

25 MS. HAMILTON-ACKER: Yes.

1 MS. HOOD: Judge Sholes?

2 JUDGE SHOLES: Yes.

3 MS. HOOD: Ms. Traylor?

4 MS. TRAYLOR: Yes.

5 MS. HOOD: Chairman Johns?

6 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Yes.

7 And by unanimous vote, that
8 resolution does carry.

9 Thank you, Mr. Gathe, for your work.

10 Appreciate it. Mr. Barbin, thank you for
11 your -- and your client for their continuous
12 work to get all this resolved. So very proud
13 of what they're doing there.

14 B. Consideration of Proposed Demolition Contract
15 for the Approved Project of Louisiana
16 Riverboat Gaming Company, LLC d/b/a
17 DiamondJacks Casino and Resort - R010800195

18 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. We move into
19 the Consideration of Proposed Demolition
20 Contract for the Approved Project of Louisiana
21 Riverboat Gaming Company, LLC, doing business
22 as, DiamondJacks Casino and Resort.

23 Good morning, Ms. Landry.

24 MS. LANDRY: Good morning,
25 Chairman Johns and Board Members.

1 I'm Assistant Attorney General Lisha
2 Landry, here for Louisiana Riverboat Gaming
3 Company, LLC, doing business as DiamondJacks
4 Casino and Resort's submission of its proposed
5 demolition contract for the approved project.

6 On December 15th, 2022, the Board
7 approved Foundation Gaming & Entertainment,
8 LLC's accusation of the Licensee, the
9 Licensee's request to construct and relocate a
10 portion of its gaming operations to a landside
11 facility located within 1,200 feet of its
12 licensed birth, financial arrangements related
13 to the construction of the facility, sale or
14 disposal of its shuttered vessel, and
15 redevelopment of the Licensee's property. In
16 order to begin demolition as soon as possible,
17 the licensee previously submitted its
18 architectural plans and specifications for the
19 demolition phase of their Approved Project,
20 which were accepted by the Board during last
21 month's board meeting.

22 On January 9th, 2023, the Licensee
23 submitted its proposed demolition contract
24 with contractor AnderCorp, LLC. The Licensee
25 anticipates beginning demolition by

1 February 1st, 2023, and expects to be
2 completed with demolition within 90 days.

3 The Attorney General's Office has
4 reviewed the proposed demolition contract and
5 found no issues that would preclude the
6 Board's acceptance of the contract. If the
7 Board accepts the Licensee's proposed contract
8 for the demolition phase of the Approved
9 Project, a resolution has been prepared for
10 the Board's adoption.

11 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. And, as I
12 understand, the budget for that work is about
13 five and a half million dollars, if I'm not
14 mistaken.

15 MS. LANDRY: Yeah. That's what was
16 submitted.

17 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Somewhere in that
18 neighborhood. So those of you that have been
19 to the DiamondJack property, I'm going to tell
20 you, it needs a lot of demolition.

21 So -- and also, Ms. Landry, as they
22 move forward, their proposed construction
23 contracts and architectural plans and all of
24 that will have to come before the Board also?

25 MS. LANDRY: Yes. This is just for

1 the demolition phase. Once this resolution is
2 adopted, they'll be able to submit their
3 architectural plans and specifications for
4 construction. And that's due before the Board
5 before the April board meeting.

6 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. Great. And
7 moving forward. Okay. Any questions for
8 Ms. Landry from the Board? Any questions?

9 MS. BERRY: I'll make a motion.

10 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: I hear none.

11 And Ms. Berry has moved that we
12 adopt the resolution.

13 MR. JACKSON: Second.

14 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: And Mr. Jackson has
15 seconded that motion.

16 And, Ms. Hood, would you read the
17 resolution, please.

18 MS. HOOD: On the 19th day of
19 January, 2023, the Louisiana Gaming Control
20 Board did, in a dually-noticed-public meeting,
21 consider the issue of the demolition contract
22 submitted by Louisiana Riverboat Gaming
23 Company, LLC, doing business as DiamondJacks
24 Casino and Resort, for demolition associated
25 with the approved project, and upon motion

1 dually made and seconded, the Board adopted
2 this resolution.

3 Be it resolved that the contract
4 submitted for the demolition phase of the
5 Approved Project be deemed submitted and
6 accepted, and the Licensee is authorized to
7 proceed with demolition according to its
8 previously submitted architectural plans and
9 specifications for the demolition. Thus done
10 and signed in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, this
11 19th day of January, 2023.

12 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Thank you,
13 Ms. Hood.

14 So we have a motion to adopt this
15 resolution by Ms. Berry. Seconded by
16 Mr. Jackson. And, Ms. Hood, would you call
17 the roll, please.

18 MS. HOOD: Ms. Berry?

19 MS. BERRY: Yes.

20 MS. HOOD: Mr. Jackson?

21 MR. JACKSON: Yes.

22 MS. HOOD: Ms. Lewis?

23 MS. LEWIS: Yes.

24 MS. HOOD: Mr. Poole?

25 MR. POOLE: Yes.

1 MS. HOOD: Ms. Hamilton-Acker?

2 MS. HAMILTON-ACKER: Yes.

3 MS. HOOD: Judge Sholes?

4 JUDGE SHOLES: Yes.

5 MS. HOOD: Ms. Traylor?

6 MS. TRAYLOR: Yes.

7 MS. HOOD: Chairman Johns?

8 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Yes.

9 By a unanimous vote, that resolution
10 is here -- hereby adopted. And, Ms. Landry,
11 thank you very much for your work.

12 VI. SETTLEMENT

13 A. Alexanderbatten, LLC D/B/A Chartres Bar

14 - No. 3601117258 (Settlement)

15 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. Moving
16 along, we have one settlement today. We have
17 the Alexanderbatten, LLC, doing business as
18 Chartres Bar.

19 Good morning.

20 MS. SIZEMORE: Good morning.

21 Chairman Johns and Members of the
22 Board, I'm Assistant Attorney General Shanna
23 Sizemore, here in the matter of a settlement
24 for Alexanderbatten, LLC, doing business as
25 Chartres Bar.

1 This settlement addresses the
2 Licensee's failure to timely submit its annual
3 licensee form, fee payment, and other required
4 documents for the 2022 renewal period.

5 Chartres Bar is a Type I bar/tavern
6 licensee located in New Orleans, Louisiana.
7 And on March 14th of 2022, the Louisiana State
8 Police, Gaming Enforcement Division emailed an
9 advisory notice informing the Licensee that
10 its annual licensee form, fee, and required
11 documents were due no latter than July 1,
12 2022. The notice also informed the Licensee
13 that failure to submit the completed form,
14 fee, and documents by August 31st, 2022, would
15 result in an administrative action.

16 On November 29th, 2022, the Division
17 received the annual licensee form, required
18 documents, and payment of the annual fee. The
19 Licensee failed to timely submit the form,
20 documents, and pay the annual fee. The
21 Licensee desired to reach a settlement in this
22 matter in lieu of proceeding with the
23 administrative action, and the Division
24 agreed.

25 The Licensee has agreed to pay a

1 civil penalty of \$750 under the terms of the
2 settlement This amount is in line with other
3 cases where a licensee submitted its forms and
4 fees after August 31st.

5 The settlement has been signed by
6 the Licensee and the Hearing Officer, and is
7 now before the Board for final consideration.

8 If you have any questions, I will
9 answer them.

10 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Okay. Thank you,
11 Ms. Sizemore. And any questions from the
12 Board? Any questions?

13 I would entertain a motion to
14 approve the settlement as proposed.

15 JUDGE SHOLES: So moved.

16 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: Judge Sholes has
17 moved to approve the settlement.

18 MS. LEWIS: Second.

19 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: And Ms. Lewis has
20 seconded that motion.

21 Is there any opposition to that
22 motion? Hearing none, that motion carries.

23 Members, we have set a record today
24 for a short meeting. So -- but before we
25 leave, I do want to say this and share with

1 the Board and the public that our longtime
2 employee, Ms. Natalie Thurman, who has been at
3 the Board office for 23 years, as I
4 understand, has taken retirement. She is
5 going -- she has retired officially as of
6 last -- last Friday was her last day. So on
7 behalf of the Board and the State of
8 Louisiana, we want to thank Ms. Thurman for 23
9 years of incredible service to the Louisiana
10 Gaming Control Board. We want to wish her the
11 very best of luck wherever life journey takes
12 her. And so we just wanted everyone to wish
13 Ms. Thurman the very best of luck. So just
14 wanted to share that with everybody.

15 Members, next month, as I said
16 earlier, we will have a presentation from
17 Horseshoe, and we will move -- we'll move
18 forward with that.

19 VII. ADJOURNMENT

20 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: I would entertain a
21 motion for Mr. Jackson.

22 MR. JACKSON: So moved.

23 CHAIRMAN JOHNS: He's my go-to guy
24 on the adjournment. And Ms. Berry has
25 seconded that motion to adjourn.

1 Is there any opposition? Hearing
2 none, we're hereby adjourned. And thank you
3 very much, Members, for making that a short
4 meeting.
