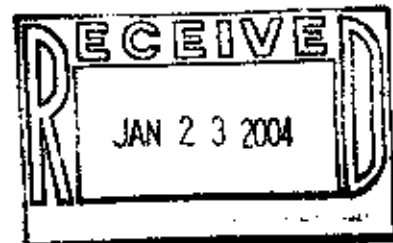

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND  
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

**ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:**

1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Casino Gaming Section (hereinafter "Section"), and
2. Leon Bryant, Permit No. 040028823 (hereinafter "Permittee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

**WHEREAS:**

1. On or about July 24, 2003, the Permittee submitted a renewal application for a Non-Key Gaming Employee Permit;
2. A background investigation was performed and a permit was issued to the Permittee with an expiration date of August 19, 2003;
3. On or about August 29, 2003, The Section received notification from the Louisiana Department of Revenue that the Permittee was not current in the filing of all applicable tax returns or in the payment of all taxes owed;
4. On or about September 9, 2003, the Section sent a notice to the Permittee, advising it to submit documentation within thirty (30) calendar days that exemplified a tax clearance had been issued;
5. The Section did not receive a tax clearance from the Louisiana Department of Revenue concerning the Permittee within the thirty (30) calendar day time delay;
6. Attendant to the notice, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension to the Permittee on or about November 4, 2003, for the Permittee's failure to remain current in his filing of all applicable tax returns or in the payment of all his taxes owed;

7. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on January 6, 2004 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Joseph E. Anzalone, Jr.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Section and the Permittee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The Permittee acknowledges that he was in violation of La. R.S. 27:28(B)(3) and La. R.S. 27:28(F), in that he did not remain current in filing all applicable tax returns and in the payment of all taxes, penalties, and interest owed to the State of Louisiana;
2. The Permittee has submitted documentation evidencing a tax clearance has been issued; a copy of which is attached hereto;
3. In lieu of an administrative action, the Permittee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
4. The Section hereby agrees to accept the Permittee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of this Notice of Recommendation of Suspension;
5. The Section reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
6. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
7. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Section and the Permittee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
8. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Section within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the non-key gaming employee permit of the Permittee being suspended; and
9. The Section and the Permittee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.





1. The Permittee acknowledges that he was in violation of La. R.S. 27:28(B)(3) and La. R.S. 27:28(F), in that he did not remain current in filing all applicable tax returns and in the payment of all taxes, penalties, and interest owed to the State of Louisiana;
2. having submitted the documentation evidencing a tax clearance has been issued untimely to the Section, the Permittee shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$250.00;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the non-key gaming permit of Leon Bryant being suspended.
