COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Oubre Companies, LLC d/b/a Teche Bar (hereinafter, "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has sent a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Licensee, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by said Notice are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office.

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with said Notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. The Licensee is a Type 1 licensed establishment located at 5316 Main Highway, Saint Martinville, Louisiana, 70582.

- 2. On July 5, 2022, the Division received an Annual Licensee Form and supporting documents from the Licensee.
- 3. According to the documents, Blake Oubre, who previously held a 50% ownership interest in the company, assigned 1% of his ownership interest to Wayne Oubre (hereinafter, "Mr. Oubre"), and the remaining 49% to Charlotte Oubre (hereinafter, "Mrs. Oubre").
 - 4. Mr. Oubre originally held a 50% ownership interest in the Licensee.
- 5. Accordingly, the current membership of the Licensee consists of Mr. Oubre, with a 51% ownership interest, and Mrs. Oubre, with a 49% ownership interest.
 - 6. The assignments of interest were effective on January 27, 2022.
- 7. The Licensee failed to notify the Division within ten calendar days of the assignments of interest, in violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. In lieu of administrative action, Licensee will pay a penalty of FIVE HUNDRED and NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS for its violation of LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a total penalty of FIVE HUNDRED and NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Licensee's suitability.
- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement 5. between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the

parties.

б. This Compromise and Sculement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing

Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed

settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be

submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve

same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

If approved, Licensee agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty within fifteen 7.

(15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Licensee agrees

that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the gaming license

without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in

full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and

terms and conditions hereof.
