# JOINT ENTRY FOR STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

On Joint Motion of:

- (i) The State of Louisiana, Office of State Police, Riverboat Gaming Division.

  ("Division"), and
- (ii) Joseph Giaimo ("Mr. Giaimo"), enter the following Stipulations into the record:

WHEREAS, by Notice of Violation and Hearing ("Notice") dated December 1, 2000, the Division alleged that on or about July 28, 1999, Mr. Giaimo, along with six (6) other individuals, formed a limited liability company called Onisac, LLC ("Onisac"). Mr. Giaimo initially invested approximately \$60,444 in Onisac, which gave him thirty-two percent (32%) ownership of Onisac, and was also appointed president of Onisac. The Articles of Incorporation for Onisac were filed with the California Secretary of State on September 3, 1999.

WHEREAS, the Notice alleged that on or about August 30, 1999, Onisac entered into a purchase agreement with Jok-erz Wild Casino, Inc. ("Jok-erz Wild") whereby Onisac agreed to purchase the assets of Jok-erz Wild for \$150,000.00 and gave Leonard Fleisher, a shareholder in Jok-erz Wild, three percent (3%) ownership in Onisac. Additionally, on August 30, 1999, Onisac entered into a lease agreement with Leonard Fleisher and others for purposes of leasing the building and premises where Jok-erz Wild

was located. The lease specifically provided that the "tenant is willing to lease the premises for the purposes of operating a bar, restaurant, and gaming operation."

WHEREAS, on or about June 20, 1996, Mr. Giaimo submitted to the Division an original application for a key gaming employee permit. Question #17 on page seventeen (17) of the original application states "List you work history for the past ten years, including all businesses with which you have been involved, all periods of self-employment, and all periods of unemployment." Additionally, Question #1 on page twenty-four (24) of the original application states: "If you have ever held an ownership, beneficial, pecuniary, financial, or other interest in any Gaming Operation, state for each Gaming Operation, (A) The dates, by month and year, during which you held an interest in the Gaming Operations; (B) The name, address and telephone number of the Gaming Operation; (C) The current name, address and telephone numbers of the Gaming Operation's Registered Agents and Key Persons; (D) A description of the Gaming Operation and of your interest in the Gaming Operation."

WHEREAS, the Notice alleged that on or about April 18, 2000, Mr. Giaimo submitted to the Division a renewal application for his key gaming employee permit. Included as part of the renewal application was the Gaming Permit Affidavit, wherein Mr. Giaimo attested to the fact of statement #3 on the affidavit which states: "The answers and other information contained in my original Gaming Permit Application have remained the same, or if any answers or other information has changed, I am providing an updated answer or updated information on a separate sheet of paper which is attached to and made part of this Renewal Application."

WHEREAS, the Notice alleged that Mr. Giaimo failed to disclose his involvement with and interest in Onisac on his 2000 renewal application for his key gaming employee permit and also failed to amend his 1999 renewal application to include this information in violation of La. 27:70(A)(1), La. R.S. 27:76(A)(2), LAC 42:XIII.2141(A), and LAC 42:XIII.2127(B).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration for the foregoing Stipulations, the Division and Mr. Giaimo hereby propose the following settlement:

- 1. Mr. Giaimo admits that he unintentionally failed to disclose his involvement with and interest in Onisac on his 2000 key gaming employee permit renewal application in violation of LAC 42:XIII.2141(A) and LAC 42:XIII.2127(B).
- 2. Mr. Giaimo admits that he unintentionally failed to amend his 1999 key gaming employee permit renewal application to include information regarding his involvement with and interest in Onisac in violation of LAC 42:XIII.2127(B).
- 3. Mr. Giaimo will pay to the Division as a civil penalty for the aforementioned violations the aggregate and complete sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$500.00).
- 4. Subject to the approval of the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Division hereby agrees to accept Mr. Giaimo's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of this Incident RGS000296.
- 5. It is expressly understood that this proposed settlement, if approved by the Hearing Officer, is not executory and will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control

Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer. The parties hereby consent to this procedure.

6. The Division and Mr. Giaimo waive their rights to appeal this Stipulation if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and is accepted by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

7. The Division reserves the right to take this matter into consideration in connection with any subsequent violations.

8. This Stipulation and Proposed Settlement is to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

9. This Stipulation and Propose Settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Mr. Giaimo pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
