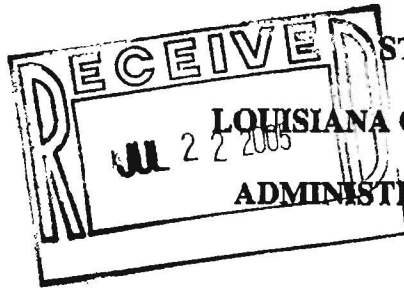

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT****ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:**

1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. Fox & Hound of Louisiana d/b/a Fox & Hound English Pub No. 260011439 (hereinafter "Licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On April 3, 2004, the Internal Revenue Service, notified the Division that the Licensee was delinquent in the filing or payment of taxes, and therefore ineligible for a tax clearance.
2. On November 30, 2004, the Division issued a letter, via certified mail, instructing the Licensee to resolve the tax delinquency within thirty (30) days. On December 6, 2004, Jessica Mauer signed the return receipt acknowledging receipt of the letter.
3. On March 3, 2005 the IRS issued a tax clearance for the Licensee.
4. On April 14, 2005 the Notice of Availability of Compliance Conference was received by the Licensee, as indicated by the signed certified mail receipt, to address the period of non-compliance.
5. On May 2, 2005 the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action, it was received on May 11, 2005.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:


1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(1)(b), in that it did not remain current in the filing/payment of taxes with the Internal Revenue Service for a portion of the existence of the its license;
2. The licensee is current in the filing/payment of its taxes with the Internal Revenue Service;
3. In lieu of further administrative action against the licensee's Type 1 video gaming license, the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
4. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
5. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Fox & Hound of Louisiana d/b/a Fox & Hound English Pub pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Board within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended until the civil penalty is paid in full;

8. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.


