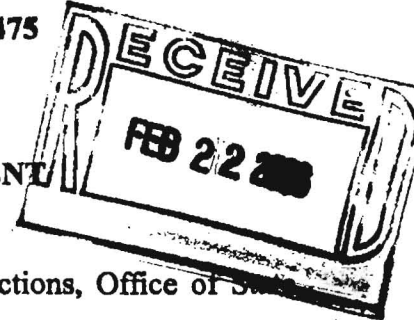

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "the Division") and EHM, Ltd. d/b/a Mr. Ed's Fried Chicken, No. 2600212475, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to EHM, Ltd. d/b/a Mr. Ed's Fried Chicken, which notice alleges certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on February 22, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. EHM, Ltd. d/b/a Mr. Ed's Fried Chicken, a licensed video gaming establishment, previously entered into a video poker device agreement with Master Video Poker.

2. Master Video Poker sent video gaming documents ("the Documents") to EHM, Ltd. d/b/a Mr. Ed's Fried Chicken for execution, including but not limited to the Request to Release Information form, dated September 22, 2003, which was signed by Songkram Rodchuer.

3. Songkram Rodchuer is the Director of EHM, Ltd. d/b/a Mr. Ed's Fried Chicken.

4. Songkram Rodchuer admits that he did not sign the Documents in the presence of a notary and the Documents were not notarized in the Affiant's presence. Thus, the Documents were improperly notarized in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(A)(15).

5. On December 7, 2005, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to EHM, Ltd. D/B/A Mr. Ed's Fried Chicken, No. 2600212475, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

6. Songkram Rodchuer represents that all of the statements, responses, disclosures and representations provided in documents submitted to the Division bearing his signature, are true and correct to the best of his knowledge, information and belief, and represent a complete and accurate account of the requested information.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Any and all information discovered throughout the course of this or any other investigation may be used in any future determination of the suitability of Songkram Rodchuer.

2. EHM, Ltd. d/b/a Mr. Ed's Fried Chicken agrees to pay a civil penalty of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

3. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and EHM, Ltd. d/b/a Mr. Ed's Fried Chicken, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this


A true and correct copy of the proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference for all purposes.
