#### COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "the Division") and Juneau Marine Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Inc. (hereinafter "Juneau" or "Permittee"), P085502548, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to Juneau, which notice alleges certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty are set for hearing on May 19, 2008, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

#### **STIPULATIONS**

- Pursuant to La. R.S. 27:29(I) and La. R.S. 27:29(3)(F), the Permittee is required to submit an Annual fee and Annual affidavit by December 21, which represents its permit anniversary date.
- 2. Juneau failed to timely submit the required annual forms and fees in 2006 and again in 2007.
- 3. On May 2, 2008, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued an Amended Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty to Juneau, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permittee agrees to pay a civil penalty of Five Hundred and Sixty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$562.50) per year of violation for a total civil penalty of One Thousand One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$1,125.00).
- 2. If approved, Juneau must make payment of the civil penalty to the Division within ten (10) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violations.
- 4. Any and all information discovered throughout the course of this or any other investigation may be used in any future determination of the suitability of the Permittee.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Juneau pertaining to the subject matter contained

herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by

the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood

that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not

thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its

determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing

Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be

interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement, understand it, and agree to all

stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
