COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State

Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and Alsco, Incorporated (hereinafter "Permittee") do hereby

represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of

Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty ("Notice") to Permittee alleging certain violations

of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice are set for hearing on October 22, 2008,

before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally compromising

and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties do hereby agree and

stipulate as follows:

**STIPULATIONS** 

1. Permittee admits to violating La. R.S. 27:29(I) and La R.S. 27:29.3(F) when it

submitted its 2008 Annual Affidavit and License Fee after its June 26, 2008, anniversary date.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. In lieu of suspension of Permittee's Non-Gaming Supplier Permit, Permittee will pay a civil penalty of FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS and a penalty of SIXTY-TWO DOLLARS AND 50/100 (\$62.50) DOLLARS pursuant to La. R.S. 27:29.5(C).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Permittee's payment of the above stated penalties in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Suspension and Penalty issued on August 18, 2008.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty.
- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Permittee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, and to comply with each term and condition listed herein, shall result in the continued suspension of Permittee's permit without the necessity of further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions thereof.
