

COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and South Park Tavern, Inc. D/B/A South Park Tavern, Inc. (hereinafter "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Licensee alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on September, 17, 2008, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. Licensee admits that Scott E. Sirmon was arrested on March 7, 2008, by the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office for violating La R.S. 14:35.3, Domestic Abuse/Battery. This charge was subsequently refused by the prosecuting authority.

2. Licensee admits to violating LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4) when it failed to notify the Division of Mr. Sirmon's arrest within ten (10) calendar days.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Licensee will pay a civil penalty of FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS.

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept Licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action issued on July 15, 2008.

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty.

4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, and to comply with each term and condition listed herein, shall result in

the immediate suspension of South Park Tavern, Inc's. license without the necessity of further administrative action, until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.


