#### COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and Cajun Magic Truck Stop, License No. 5501511641 (hereinafter "Licensee") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Enforcement Division has issued a Notice of Violation and Penalty to Licensee, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Violation and Penalty are set for hearing on November 28, 2007, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Violation and Penalty;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

#### **STIPULATIONS**

1. Licensee stipulates that on August 8, 2007, the Division conducted a routine inspection of the local area in reference to the video poker advertisement billboards. The

inspection was to ensure that the billboards were in compliance with the new regulations concerning problem gamblers' toll-free telephone number. The Division observed a total of three (3) Royal Flush Casino Billboards were not in compliance with the new regulations and did not meet the requirements. Licensee stipulates that this non-compliance was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2407(D)(5) and LAC 42:XI.2407(D)(6). As a result of this conduct, a Violation/Inspection Report was issued on August 8, 2007.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee shall pay a total of Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars for the above-referenced violation of LAC 42:XI.2407(D)(5) and LAC 42:XI.2407(D)(6).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to a total of Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars in fines for the Licensee's violation of LAC 42:XI.2407(D)(5) and LAC 42:XI.2407(D)(6).
- 3. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

6. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, Licensee must pay Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license until payment of penalty is received without the necessity of any further administrative action.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
