

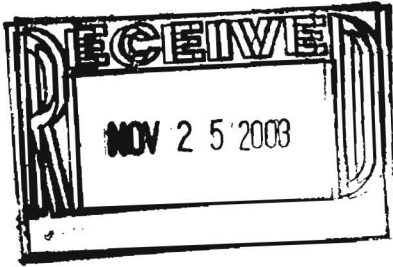

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:


1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. Paradise Poker, Inc., License No. 2600609480 (hereinafter "licensee"),

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On or about March 1, 2003, the Division mailed the annual form, which must be submitted annually by all licensees, to the licensee;
2. The licensee was mandated by La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4), LAC 42:X1.2405(B)(4) and (7) to submit the above annual form to the Division, along with all appropriate fees and current tax clearance certificates, on or before July 1, 2003;
3. On or about July 1, 2003, the Division received the licensee's annual form, fees and local tax clearance; however, the state tax clearance certificate was not included;
4. On July 9, 2003, the Division sent the licensee certified notification of its failure to submit the required state tax clearance;
5. On July 29, 2003, the Division issued Violation/Inspection Report #14453 to the licensee, citing violation of LAC 42:X1.2405(B)(7);
6. Attendant to the Violation/Inspection Report, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the licensee on or about October 9, 2003; and

7. This matter has been scheduled for hearing on December 2, 2003 at 9:00 a.m. before the Honorable William H. Brown,


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(7), in that it did not submit the state tax clearance certificate to the Division by July 1, 2003;
2. In lieu of further administrative action, the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
3. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 14453 and this Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;
4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Paradise Poker, Inc. pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled; and
8. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.



Considering the foregoing Joint Motion For Entry of Stipulations and Approval of Proposed Settlement, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such proposed settlement be approved, to wit:

1. the licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:X1.2405(B)(7), in that it did not submit the state tax clearance certificate to the Division by July 1, 2003;
2. the licensee shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$250.00;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the state within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of the licensee being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled.
