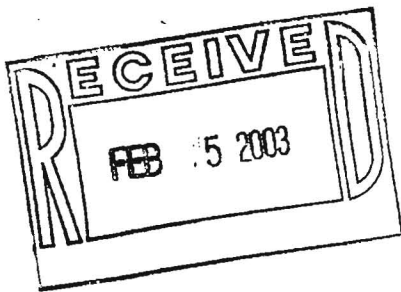

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division (hereinafter "Division"), and
2. Cor-Mel Royal Street, LLC d/b/a T.G.I. Friday's- License No. 3601212047 (hereinafter "licensee").

who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

1. On or about March 8, 2002, the Division mailed the annual form, which must be submitted annually by all licensees, to the licensee;
2. The licensee was mandated by La. R.S. 27:311(K)(4), LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4) and (7) to submit the above annual form to the Division, along with all appropriate fees and current tax clearance certificates, on or before July 1, 2002;
3. The licensee failed to submit the required state and local tax clearance certificate by July 1st;
4. Pursuant to this information, the Division issued a Notice of Violation and Hearing (Violation/Inspection Report #13879) to the licensee on or about September 24, 2002, alleging violations of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(7);
5. Subsequently, the licensee submitted the state and local tax clearance certificates to the below counsel for the Division whom has attached these documents;

6. This matter has been scheduled for hearing before the Honorable Joseph E. Anzalone, Jr..


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing stipulations, the Division and the licensee hereby propose the following settlement, that:

1. The licensee acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(7), in that it did not submit the state or local tax clearance to the Division by July 1, 2002;
2. In lieu of revocation or suspension of the licensee's video gaming license, the licensee shall pay a \$250.00 civil penalty;
3. The Division hereby agrees to accept the licensee's payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of Violation/Inspection Report No. 13879;
4. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these violations in connection with any future violation;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Cor-Mel Royal Street, LLC d/b/a T.G.I. Friday's pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalties must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board; the failure to submit the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of Cor-Mel Royal Street, LLC d/b/a T.G.I. Friday's being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled; and
8. The Division and the licensee waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.



1. Cor-Mel Royal Street, LLC d/b/a T.G.I. Friday's acknowledges that it was in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(7), in that it did not submit state or local tax clearances to the Division by July 1, 2002;
2. Cor-Mel Royal Street, LLC d/b/a T.G.I. Friday's shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$250.00;
3. payment of the above penalty shall be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; and
4. the failure to submit the above penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval by Cor-Mel Royal Street, LLC d/b/a T.G.I. Friday's of this settlement by the Board shall result in the video gaming license of being suspended and its gaming devices being disabled.
