COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Oince of State Police (hereinafter the "Division") and 5101 West Esplanade, Ltd. d/b/a Austin's Restaurant (hereinafter "AUSTIN'S") do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to AUSTIN'S alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on March 9, 2006, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the Division and AUSTIN'S are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

1. On or about March 1, 2004, the Division mailed an annual licensee form (DPSSP 6643) to AUSTIN'S by U.S. mail service. As indicated in this mailing, and by rule, the licensee is required to submit the appropriate licensing fee and tax clearances no later than July 1.

- 2. On or about August 19, 2004, the Division received the requested licensing fee and tax clearance.
- 3. On or about October 14, 2004, the gold copy of violation/inspection #15009 was mailed to AUSTIN'S advising of the violation for not timely submitting these items. On November 29, 2004, the Division received a certified return receipt card, signed by Christopher Davis, indicating that the establishment had received the violation/inspection report on November 24, 2004.
- 4. AUSTIN'S does admit it violated La. R.S. 27:310(B)(1)(c), LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(4)(b), and LAC 42:XIII.2903(A).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. AUSTIN'S will pay a civil penalty of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS.
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept AUSTIN'S payment of the above stated penalty in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action issued on December 2, 2005.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty.
- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and AUSTIN'S, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits. Failure to pay the penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement shall result in the immediate suspension of AUSTIN'S permit.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
