DECISION OF THE
LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

IN RE: CODY'S ENTERPRISES, INC. D/B/A
CALCASIEU EXXON
NO. 1001512817

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board ("Board") on appeal by Cody's Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Calcasieu Exxon, No. 1001512817, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated May 7, 2014, in which the license was revoked because federal and state tax clearances were not provided for the licensee and its 100% shareholder, Albert C. Broussard, and a state tax clearance was not provided for Shelia A. Broussard, Secretary/Treasurer of the licensee.

In its appeal, the licensee alleges that all required tax clearances have now been provided to the Louisiana State Police ("Division".) These tax clearances are not part of the record and cannot be considered.

We will remand this matter to the Hearing Officer for the introduction of the tax clearances. He will consider this evidence and render a decision accordingly which may include revocation, suspension and the imposition of a civil penalty. Either party may then appeal.

ORDER

This matter having been considered by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board in open meeting of July 24, 2014:

IT IS ORDERED THAT this matter be REMANDED for the purpose and reasons set forth in this decision.
