## DECISION OF THE LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

## IN RE: DENNIS L. BROWN NO. P040061570

This matter is before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board on appeal by Dennis L. Brown, Permit No. P040061570, from the Hearing Officer's decision dated January 8, 2015, in which his non-key gaming employee permit was revoked. At the time of the hearing, Mr. Brown had pled guilty to a felony, Improper Photography, which rendered Mr. Brown disqualified from holding a permit under the provisions of La. R.S. 27:28(B).

At the hearing, Mr. Brown introduced letters regarding his good character from his coworkers but the Hearing Officer did not consider these. The Hearing Officer found that a determination as to Mr. Brown's character and general suitability under the provisions of La. R.S. 27:28(A)<sup>2</sup> was not needed because Mr. Brown was statutorily disqualified from holding a

permit.

In his appeal, Mr. Brown alleges that the statute under which he was charged and pled guilty has since been declared unconstitutional. He attached a Judgment of Acquittal in his criminal case wherein the court ordered that Mr. Brown was not guilty of the charged offense. Mr. Brown argues that he is no longer statutorily disqualified.

We cannot consider evidence which is not part of the record with the Hearing Office.

The Office of State Police (the "Division") asks that the Board uphold the Hearing Officer's decision or, in the alternative, remand this matter for consideration of new evidence and consideration of Mr. Brown's general suitability under the provisions of La. R.S. 28(D).

The Division argues that Mr. Brown does not meet the general suitability criteria of La. R.S. 27:28(A).

We agree with the Division that Mr. Brown does not meet the general suitability requirements and will affirm the Hearing Officer's decision to revoke Mr. Brown's permit.

board or division, where applicable, that he is suitable. For the purposes of this Title, "suitable" means the applicant, licensee, casino gaming operator, permittee, or other person is:

<sup>(1)</sup> A person of good character, honesty, and integrity.

<sup>(2)</sup> A person whose prior activities, criminal record, if any, reputation, habits, and associations do not pose a threat to the public interest of this state or to the effective regulation and control of gaming, or create or enhance the dangers of unsuitable, unfair, or illegal practices, methods, and activities in the conduct of gaming or carrying on of the business and financial arrangements incidental thereto.

<sup>(3)</sup> Capable of and likely to conduct the activities for which the applicant, licensee, permittee, casino gaming operator, or licensed eligible facility is licensed, permitted, or approved pursuant to the provisions of this Title.

<sup>(4)</sup> Not disqualified pursuant to the provisions of Subsection B of this Section.

## **ORDER**

This matter having been considered by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board in open meeting of March 19, 2015:

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Hearing Officer's decision is AFFIRMED.
