A true and correct copy of the proposed Compromise and Settlement Agreement




is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference for all purposes.



**COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "the Division") and Mickey O'Connor General Contractor, Inc. (hereinafter "the Permittee"), a Non-Gaming Supplier, Permit No. P0838802364, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Mickey O'Connor General Contractor, Inc. which notice alleges certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on January 7, 2009, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

## STIPULATIONS

1. On June 13, 2008, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Mickey O'Connor General Contractor, Inc. alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

2. Pursuant to LAC 42:VII.2901(B)(4), LAC 42: IX.2901(B)(4), and LAC 42:XIII. 2901(B)(4), the Permittee has a continuing duty to notify the Division of any fact, event, occurrence, matter or action that may affect the conduct of gaming or the business.

3. The Permittee admits it did not timely disclose changes in the officers and directors of the corporation.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Mickey O'Connor General Contractor, Inc. agrees to pay a civil penalty of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3500.00).

2. The Division hereby agrees to accept the payment of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3500.00) in settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.

3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted stipulations and violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future determination of the suitability of Mickey O'Connor General Contractor, Inc.

4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its

determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.


5. If approved, the Permittee must make payment of the civil penalty and delinquency fee to the Division within ten (10) days of approval by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate suspension of the license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

6. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.






