

LOUISIANA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

Minutes of October 16, 2025

The monthly meeting of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board (the “Board”) convened on Thursday, October 16, 2025, 10:00 a.m., at the Louisiana State Capitol – House Committee Room 1. Present at the meeting were Chairman Christopher Hebert, Kathryn Becnel, Franchesca Hamilton-Acker, Miquell Hennigan, Claude Jackson, Nicholas Langley, Julie Lewis, Ronald Sholes, and Ashley Traylor. Captain Jonas Martin was present for Col. Robert Hodges and Brian Peters was present for Sec. Richard Nelson. Absent were ex officio members Col. Hodges and Sec. Nelson.

Chairman Hebert called the meeting to order. There were no public comments made.

Chairman Hebert took the opportunity to thank former Vice-Chairman Lamar Poole for his years of service and dedication to the Board, and introduced the Board’s new member, Ms. Miquell Hennigan.

It was moved by Mr. Langley to waive the reading and approve the minutes of the September 18, 2025 Board meeting. That motion was seconded by Ms. Becnel and unanimously approved by the Board.

Donna Jackson, Louisiana State Police (“LSP”) Gaming Audit Section, provided revenue reports for the riverboats, slots at the racetracks, and land-based casino. She also reported on video poker, retail and mobile sports wagering, and daily fantasy sports contest revenue.

The Board considered the Certificate of Compliance for the Alternate Riverboat Inspection of the gaming vessel for Louisiana – I Gaming, a Louisiana Partnership in Commendam d/b/a Boomtown New Orleans – No. R012600196. After presentations by Kanick Lewis, Assistant Attorney General, and John Francic on behalf of American Vessel Services, LLC (“AVS”), it was moved by Mr. Sholes to approve the issuance of an annual certificate of compliance for the riverboat gaming vessel. That motion was seconded by Ms. Hamilton-Acker and unanimously approved by the Board.

The Board considered the Certificate of Compliance for the Riverboat Gaming Temporary Landside Facility of Catfish Queen, LLC d/b/a Belle of Baton

Rouge – No. R011700009. After a presentation by Kanick Lewis, Assistant Attorney General, it was moved by Ms. Lewis to approve the issuance of an annual certificate of compliance for the temporary landside facility. That motion was seconded by Ms. Traylor and unanimously approved by the Board.

The Board considered the original truck stop application for 5303 Paris Casino, LLC d/b/a Paris Casino – No. 4400517082. After presentations by Matthew Meek, Assistant Attorney General, and Investigator Glenn Verrett, LSP Gaming Enforcement Division, it was moved by Mr. Sholes to approve the truck stop application. That motion was seconded by Ms. Becnel and approved by the Board with the Chairman abstaining from voting on the matter.

The Board considered the transfer of membership interest for Red River Casino, LLC d/b/a Red River Casino – No. 0800517624. After presentations by Bria Jones, Assistant Attorney General, and Master Trooper James Cannon, LSP Gaming Enforcement Division, it was moved by Mr. Langley to approve the transfer of membership interest in the licensee. That motion was seconded by Ms. Lewis and unanimously approved by the Board.

Chairman Hebert announced that the November Board meeting will take place on Thursday, November 13, 2025, at the Louisiana State Capitol Building.

There being no further business, it was moved by Mr. Jackson to adjourn the meeting. That motion was seconded by Ms. Hamilton-Acker and the meeting adjourned without objection.
