IN RE: THE CRAWFISH SHACK, L.L.C. D/B/A THE CRAWFISH SHACK, L.L.C. NO. VP0100212930

The Louisiana State Police Video Gaming Division seeks to have the Louisiana Gaming Control Board (Board) recall the Notice of Revocation issued to The Crawfish Shack because it was issued in error.

On July 1, 2003, The Crawfish Shack voluntarily surrendered its video gaming license to the Division. Approximately three months later, administrative action was initiated against The Crawfish Shack.\(^1\) Due to a reporting error, neither the Division agent who recommended the initiation of administrative action nor the Board was aware of the pre-existing surrender when administrative action was initiated. Because there was no license against which to proceed, the revocation was an absolute nullity. Accordingly, the recommendation of administrative action and the notice of revocation should be recalled.

ORDER

This matter having been considered by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board in open meeting of January 20, 2004:

IT IS ORDERED THAT the "Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action" and "Notice of Revocation" having been issued in error are RECALLED.
