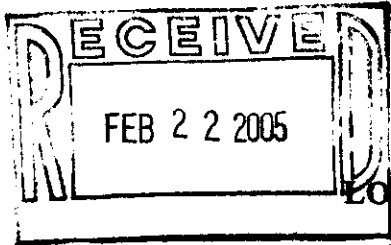

**JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

1. the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "Division"), represented herein by the undersigned Assistant Attorney General, and
2. Limousine Livery, Ltd. (herein "applicant"), represented herein by its undersigned counsel,

who respectfully enter the following stipulations into the record:

WHEREAS:

1. Following an investigation of the Original Application for a Non-Gaming Supplier Permit of the applicant, the Division recommended denial of the application;
2. The Division issued a Notice of Denial of Original Application to the applicant on January 24, 2005, citing La. RS 27:28(A)(2), La. RS 27:28(A)(3), La. RS 27:28(E), LAC 42:XII.2157(A), LAC 42:IX.2149(A)(8), LAC 42:IX.2135(A) and LAC 42:VII.2157(A), as its authority for said denial;
3. The Division has reviewed this matter and received additional information by sworn deposition; and
4. This matter is scheduled for hearing on February 22, 2004, at 9:00 a.m., before the Honorable William H. Brown.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations and the particular facts and circumstances of this matter, the Division and the applicant hereby propose the following settlement:

1. The Division shall recommend that the applicant be approved for a non-gaming supplier permit;
2. The applicant agrees that, contemporaneous with the submission of annual fee due on each anniversary of the issuance of the permit, it will provide to the Division tax clearances from the Internal Revenue Service and Louisiana Department of Revenue;
3. Further, the applicant agrees that, contemporaneous with the submission of annual fee due on each anniversary of the issuance of the permit, it will provide to the Division tax clearances from the Internal Revenue Service and Louisiana Department of Revenue for all persons associated with the applicant that have been, or are required to be, found suitable;
4. Failure to provide the tax clearances shall be cause for the immediate suspension of the applicant's permit;
5. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana;
6. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Limousine Livery, Ltd. to the subject matter contained herein, and supercedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties;
7. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; and
8. The Division and the applicant waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the attached Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board, and the non-gaming supplier permit is issued to the applicant.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that the foregoing proposed settlement be approved, to-wit:

Limousine Livery, Ltd. shall, contemporaneous with the submission of the annual fee due on each anniversary of the issuance of its permit, provide to the Division tax clearances from the Internal Revenue Service and Louisiana Department of Revenue for all persons associated with the applicant that have been, or are required to be, found suitable;
4. Failure to provide the tax clearances specified hereinabove shall be cause for the immediate suspension of the Limousine Livery, Ltd.'s permit.
